UK Draught Beers

Welcome to the real ale bar.

This year we will have more beers than ever before at Ealing Beer Festival. At the time of writing over 300 are on order but the exact number seems to be fluctuating by the hour. We hope there will be beers to suit all tastes, ranging from 2.5% ABV up to a staggering (probably literally!) 10.5% stout. The range is a variety of returning friends and some new faces.

A few words on how it all works. The beers are arranged roughly alphabetically across three bars, each of which is named for one our friends in breweryland. A few may appear in odd places, often because they were late replacements so a little juggling may be required. **We do not hold beer back**. Once one becomes drinkable it will display an A4 label, an indication that it is available. The labels come in a variety of colours, roughly matching the dots you will find in the tasting notes which follow and indicating which style of beer lurks within. There is a key below.

It is not easy to pick out beers for special mentions but here goes. This year we have three festival special beers. Those of you who were with us last year and enjoyed the XT Raspberry Beer will be interested to know that they are providing us with two special fruit beers this year: Apricot and Blackcurrant. Quite how you make a blonde beer with blackcurrants I am looking forward to finding out. The third festival special is from Aeronaut. This is one of the two new brewpubs to have opened in Acton since the last festival. They will be doing a Ruby Mild for us, not least because in addition to being the 25th Ealing Beer Festival, it is also CAMRA West Middlesex's 40th anniversary year.

We also have a new beer from Twickenham, Mosaic Pale, making its debut at the festival. At 3.2% ABV it should be perfect for drinking in the fine summer weather we are hoping for.

Amongst other rarities are a couple of beers from Arkells which are only available for a limited period and four from Blue Anchor in Helston, Cornwall, which are not often seen in these parts. The same can also be said of Donnington, a brewery set in an idyllic location in the Cotswolds which is partly water powered. We will also have beers from Heavy Industry making their London debut all the way from north Wales but it is OK to order them in English. High House Nettle Beer could be interesting. When I (selflessly) visited the brewery in May, they hadn't brewed it yet.

Finally, a quick word of thanks to all of those involved in the whole process of selecting, ordering, preparing and serving the real ales at Ealing Beer Festival's 25th incarnation. All are volunteers and without them it simply would not happen.

ACORN - Wombwell, South Yorkshire

Gorlovka Stout – 6.0%

Deep ebony in colour with bags of malt, spicy hop bitterness and a fruity dry finale.

AERONAUT - Acton, Greater London

Summer Loving - 3.5%

A classic pale session ale full of summery flavours evoking hoppy festival vibes.

C Amber - 3.7%

A sessionable amber ale with a well balanced malt profile, light bitterness and good hit of late-boil Chinook and Summit US hops for some zesty, floral aroma.

Acton Blonde - 3.8%

An easy drinking blonde ale packed full of beautifully aromatic and rare Simcoe hops from the USA giving a piney, citrusy aroma that lingers on the palate.

Ruby Mild – 4.0%

FESTIVAL SPECIAL - A dark ruby mild brewed specially for this festival.

Porter - 4.6%

A rich, dark, malty porter with chocolate and coffee notes, lightly hopped with two American varieties.

Sorcerers - 5.0%

It's all about the hops in this USA style IPA. Four resinous, floral varieties combine to provide a pint with a punch while remaining pleasantly balanced against a golden malty backdrop.

Black IPA - 5.3%

Black IPA, brewed using 4 powerful US hops and dry hopped with a 5th. This powerful beer uses an excellent dark malt mix to combine an full earthy, sweet backdrop with a huge hop hit and bitter finish.

ANDWELL - Hook, Hampshire

Ruddy Darter - 4.6%

This ale is named after a deep red dragon fly found in local rivers and wetlands. The beer, the newest to the Andwell's range, uses malted rye to create its characteristic ruby glow. The flavours and aromas derive from a combination of English hops. ANIMAL - Long Crendon, Buckinghamshire Hoot - 4.6%

A unique coffee malt and English Hops in this dark creature of the night.

Doodle Doo - 4.6%

Hops Nouveau and Czech Malts combine to give a fresh pale ale.

ARKELL - Swindon, Wiltshire

📃 3B – 4.0%

A superb amber brew with distinctive taste and a full nutty malt flavour beneath the hops.

Wiltshire Gold – 4.0%

A light golden coloured Ale brewed using English Maris Otter malt, which creates a satisfyingly sweet malty flavour. The use of traditional hops give the beer a mellow floral hop aroma followed by a distinctive hoppy taste.

Wheat Beer - 4.2%

This is a classic German style Wheat beer. A distinctive crisp, fruity/spicy flavour comes through initially with a refreshing hoppy finish and some bitterness. As is typical of a wheat beer this has a gentle haze formed from the wheat grains.

Moonlight - 4.5%

Moonlight has a golden auburn colour with a warm toasty aroma and distinctive citrus hoppy flavour from Celeia hops.

The Master - 5.5%

The Master is a one off brew. It'll be a smooth, dark and full bodied porter.

ARUNDEL - Arundel, Sussex

Stronghold - 4.7%

A very smooth, full flavoured premium bitter. An excellent balance of malt, fruit and hops come through in this rich and satisfying beer.

AYLESBURY BREWHOUSE - Aylesbury,

Buckinghamshire

Codex - 3.8%

Golden brewed with English hops for a light, traditional English ale

Pure Gold - 3.8%

A light, easy drinking bitter to quench your thirst! Brewed using Maris Otter pale malt with Columbus and Pacific Gem hops. Fresh and zesty with a fruity nose and hoppy bite.

Perspective – 4.0%

Pale and brewed with lager malt, with a powerful hoppiness.

B & T - Shefford, Bedfordshire

Fruit Bat - 4.5%

A straw coloured beer, malty and fruity, lightly hopped and tasting of raspberries.

BANK TOP - Bolton, Lancashire

Dark Mild – 4.0%

A full bodied dark mild with hints of liquorice and roast barley.

BARNGATES - Ambleside, Cumbria

Red Bull Terrier - 4.8%

Deep red tones and a complex hop nose are complemented by tangy fruit and malt flavours with a spicy aftertaste.

BATEMANS - Wainfleet, Lincolnshire

XB - 3.7%

Distinctive, well balanced bitter with a refreshing dry bitterness on the palate and pleasing hoppy finish.

BEARTOWN - Congleton, Cheshire

Ginger Bear – 4.0%

The flavours from the malt and hops blend with the added bite from root ginger to produce a superbly quenching finish.

Peach Melbear - 4.4%

Refreshing blonde ale, the hoppy bitterness is balanced by the sweet aroma of peaches and elderflower. A peach of a pint!

Bearly Literate - 4.5%

Golden pale ale offering crisp hoppy flavours with a smooth malty finish. Dry hopped for a fuller flavour.

BESPOKE - Mitcheldean, Gloucestershire Leading Light - 3.5%

A refreshing clean flavoured blonde session ale with a tangy citrus flavour provided by the cascade hop finish.

Over a Barrel – 5.0%

Richly coloured fruity strong ale with generous peppery finish of goldings hops.

BLACK HOLE - Burton on Trent, Staffordshire Supernova - 4.8%

Super Nova is a premium pale ale brewed using lager malts with a top fermenting ale yeast. A variety of hops from Europe and America combine to provide a floral taste.

BLACK SHEEP - Masham, North Yorkshire Golden Sheep - 3.9%

A full flavoured cask ale with a dry and refreshing bitterness, developed with a light, citrus fruit flavour.

Celo - 4.2%

Velo (that's French for bicycle – but you knew that!) is a 4.2% ABV 'free wheeling' fresh pale ale brewed with cascade hops and an ever so subtle hint of orange and coriander. Brewed to mark the Tour de France passing the brewery.

BLACKJACK - Manchester, Greater Manchester Shuffled Deck - 3.9%

Aromas are marmalade with pine and grapefruit. Flavours are woody with sweet citrus and bitter grapefruit with a dry finish.

Stout – 5.0%

Aroma is roasted malts and chocolate syrup. Flavour is similar with a hint of maple syrup and light bitter hops. Finish is slightly fruity.

Aces High - 5.5%

Aroma has some ripe citrus notes of melon and orange. Flavour is sweet, with mild grass and pine, along with more ripe tangerine and melon.

BLUE ANCHOR - Helston, Cornwall

A clean tasting hoppy beer, originally brewed for Queen Elizabeth II's Golden Jubilee in 2002.

Ben's Stout - 4.8%

Cornish stout with malty, liquorice, chocolate and mild coffee flavours.

Spingo Middle – 5.0%

Originally brewed to welcome home those men who fought in the First World War. It is a traditional sweet Cornish bitter, with an unforgettable flavour.

Spingo Special - 6.7%

Brewed for the first time to celebrate the marriage of Prince Charles and Diana, this magnificent beer is one of the strongest brewed in Britain today. Dark in colour and sweet in taste.

BLUE BEE - Sheffield, South Yorkshire

Bee Knees Bitter – 4.0%

An appealing russet-brown bitter with lots of hops character.

Lustin' For Stout - 4.8%

A rich, complex stout, full bodied and black in colour. Plenty of roast malt flavours.

Tangled Up – 6.0%

A hoppy aroma (floral), hoppy middle (citrus flavours) and hoppy bitter finish. Oh yes, it's pale.

BOWMAN - Droxford, Hampshire

Quiver Bitter - 4.5%

Gloriously rich golden in colour and with a wonderful mown grass aroma, this premium bitter is full of complex flavours including a tiny amount of caramel. The addition of American hops gives it a full hop flavour with a dry finish.

BOX STEAM - Rode Hill, Wiltshire

Steam Porter - 4.4%

Smooth drinking, well rounded porter with a slightly smoky aroma, roasted malts give way to chocolate undertones.

BRAINS - Cardiff, Glamorgan

Dark - 3.4%

A skillful blend of dark and chocolate malts, gives this rich dark mild a full fine flavour. This beer has a delicate hop and chocolate aroma while the palate starts malty with a slight nuttiness, but then gives way to a light dry finish.

Rev James - 4.5%

Full bodied and warming, this is rich in palate spicy and aromatic with a deeply satisfying finish.

BRAKSPEAR - Witney, Oxfordshire

Oxford Gold – 4.0%

English Target hops give this beer a remarkable aroma. Late hopping with Goldings and fermentation by the Brakspear yeast creates a remarkable zesty aroma, a full fruity flavour and a golden colour.

BRECON - Brecon, Powys

Orange Beacons - 4.3%

A clear summer wheat beer infused with fresh oranges.

BRENTWOOD - Brentwood, Essex BBC2 - 2.5%

A true session beer, brown in colour with tropical citrus flavours. Dry on the palate and full of body making it taste bigger than its ABV actually is. A great example of a low ABV beer.

Chockwork Orange - 6.5%

Dark Winter ale, very smooth with hints of chocolate and orange.

BRIGHTWATER - Claygate, Surrey

Little Nipper - 3.3%

A chestnut session ale with a chocolate finish.

Top Notch - 3.6%

An amber ale with a balanced floral hop aroma.

Daisy Gold – 4.0%

A golden ale with a bittersweet aftertaste.

Wild Orchid – 4.0%

A smooth oatmeal porter further enhanced with a real vanilla pod in each cask.

All Citra - 4.3%

A golden ale utilising just Cita hops for bittering, aroma and flavour.

BUFFYS - Tivetshall St Mary, Norfolk

Mucky Duck - 4.5%

This smooth black beer is brewed using Maris Otter and Pale malts, coupled with Willamette and Styrian Golding hops to give a wonderfully balanced subtle combination of flavours, with understated chocolate and roasted tones.

BURTON BRIDGE - Burton on Trent, Staffordshire Damson Porter - 4.5%

A dark fruity beer with added damson juice, which gives a distinctive bitterness.

CAIRNGORM - Aviemore, Highlands

Sheepshaggers Gold - 4.5%

An exceptional continental style beer with good body and refreshing aftertaste.

CANTERBURY BREWERS - Canterbury, Kent **Biggleston's Bird Man - 3.6%** A Kent bitter made using East Kent Goldings and Kentish Challenger hops grown locally to the brewery on Syndale farm. A traditional beer from the heartland of hops.

C Loco IPA - 3.9%

A hoppy American-style IPA at session strength.

🔵 GB - 4.1%

An easy going, refreshing thirst quencher with a pleasant fruity bitter flavour.

Foundry Torpedo - 4.5%

An amber ale with an explosive, crisp finish.

Streetlight Porter - 5.8%

Dark, malty porter with strong toffee-chocolates and a licorice finish. Hops: Goldings & Floral Willemette.

CASTLE ROCK - Nottingham, Nottinghamshire Harvest Pale - 3.8%

Using gently kilned malt with a wonderful blend of American hops are added during the brewing process gives this pale beer beautiful poise. The hops are very noticeable and lead to a crisp aftertaste. Champion beer of Great Britain for 2010.

Black Gold - 3.8%

A well balanced dark mild ale with some bitterness, full bodied, but not overly sweet. An award winning mild that delivers a light fresh taste to one of the more traditional of beer styles.

CAVEMAN - Swanscombe, Kent

Palaeolithic - 3.8%

A light session beer with our usual dose of aromatic hops. Well balanced and highly drinkable this beer is the Swanscombe Man's favourite brew, which is why it was named after the Palaeolithic Era. Sweet malts balance out the Grapefruit and Citrus from the US Amarillo and Cascade hops to give an easy drinking session pale ale.

Citra - 4.1%

A hoppy pale ale with a straightforward malt character that really lets the citrus flavours from US Citra hops shine through. A refreshing session beer for summer days.

Clovis Point Brown - 5.2%

This US style brown ale balanced caramel and roast malt flavours against juicy hops to provide a complex yet well balanced beer. Unusual and yet very drinkable.

Cavedweller - 5.8%

A big rich porter with a full body and balanced bitterness from UK Bramling Cross hops. Chocolate and coffee notes come through in the malt and dark berry flavours from the hops.

Megalithic - 5.9%

Theres not a lot of subtlety about this beer. Big on malt, big on hops. A big biscuity malt body is balanced against a heavy hit of fruit from a blend of US hops and a fairly dry finish.

CHILTERN - Terrick, Buckinghamshire Chiltern Ale - 3.7%

Light amber in colour with a predominantly pale malty character and hints of grape and honey. An excellent quaffing ale which is light and refreshing.

Gold - 3.9%

This light golden honeyed ale dances across the tongue with summer flavours. Biscuity malt notes and hopped with UK grown Cascade producing a beautiful citrus aroma.

Beechwood Bitter - 4.3%

Mid amber in colour with a rich butter-toffee aroma. Fruity and slightly nutty. A hearty and well-rounded beer.

COACH HOUSE - Warrington, Cheshire Honevpot Bitter - 3.8%

A medium-bodied golden bitter, lightly hopped. Brewed with pure Cheshire honey which adds a luscious silkiness to a fine beer.

Banoffee - 4.2%

A medium-coloured golden brew, with a finely balanced addition of Goldings hops, and redolent of the flavour and aroma of banana and toffee.

Apricot – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of apricot.

Banana – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of banana.

Blueberry – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of blueberry.

Cherry - 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of cherry.

Coconut – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of coconut.

Cranberry – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of cranberry.

Lemon – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of lemon.

Passion Fruit – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of passion fruit.

Peach – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of peach.

Pink Grapefruit – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of pink grapefruit.

Raspberry – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of raspberry.

Strawberry – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of strawberry.

COASTAL - Redruth, Cornwall

Merry Maidens Mild – 4.0%

A classic dark mild with a good chocolate malt flavour.

Cornish Cascade – 5.0%

Single hopped with Cascade for a citrus, fruity character.

CULLERCOATS - Cullercoats, Tyne & Wear Rocket Brigade IPA - 5.5%

An authentic all English India Pale Ale. Pale, strong and bitter, yet deceptively easy drinking. Intense hoppy aroma compliments strong malty flavour.

DARK STAR - Partridge Green, Sussex

Hophead - 3.8%

An extremely clean-drinking pale golden ale with a strong floral aroma and elderflower notes from the Cascade hops. This beer is full-bodied and full-flavoured yet gentle enough to make it a favourite session beer.

Partridge Best Bitter – 4.0%

Traditional Sussex style bronze coloured bitter with a hint of rye malt and the classic Golding hops.

American Pale Ale - 4.7%

A yeast strain used for the brewing of the pale dry American Ales was specially imported from the USA, along with some Chinook and Centennial hops, to produce this pale ale. The pale Maris Otter malt provides a perfect light colour and dryness to complement the crisp taste and full aroma of the hops.

DERVENTIO - Derby, Derbyshire

Barbarian Stout - 5.5%

An oatmeal stout - Ominiously dark, smooth with a lingering finish of a subtle hop character.

DONNINGTON - Stow-on-the-Wold,

Gloucestershire

🔲 BB - 3.6%

A pleasant amber bitter with a slight hop aroma, a good balance of malt and hops in the mouth and a bitter aftertaste.

Gold – 4.0%

This award-winning beer has a golden colour with a citrus flavour followed by a rounded malt finish.

SBA - 4.4%

Malt dominates over bitterness in the subtle flavour of this premium bitter, which has a hint of fruit and a dry, malty finish.

DORSET - Weymouth, Dorset

Yachtsman - 4.7%

A medium-tasting ale; smooth with suggestions of honey.

ELLAND - Elland, West Yorkshire

1872 Porter - 6.5%

Rich, complex and dark Porter from an original 1872 recipe, with an old port nose, and coffee and bitter chocolate flavours on the palate.

ENVILLE - Stourbridge, West Midlands Cherry Blonde - 4.2%

A light blonde bitter delicately infused with essence of Cherry to produce a Belgian style fruit flavoured beer. The aroma and taste surpass expectation whilst the bitter finish is dry, hoppy and refreshing.

FLIPSIDE - Colwick, Nottinghamshire

Sterling Pale - 3.9%

A fairly hoppy pale ale. Easy drinking with a bitter, spicy hop flavour. At 3.9%, a good session ale.

FULLERS - Chiswick, Greater London

Two Halves - 3.5%

Blonde beer brewed with hops from five continents to celebrate the football World Cup.

London Porter - 5.4%

Rich, dark and complex, at 5.4% ABV the beer has an outstanding depth of flavour. It is brewed from a blend of brown, crystal and chocolate malts for a creamy delivery balanced by traditional Fuggles hops.

GOLDMARK - Arundel, Sussex

Hop Idol - 3.7%

A refreshing celebration of the mighty hop! A golden beer with pale and amber malts, combined with 4 different hop varieties entwining fruit, citrus and floral flavours.

GRAFTON - Worksop, Nottinghamshire

Framboise Raspberry Beer – 4.0%

Pale ale with the addition of raspberries which gives a zesty, citrus aroma and a subtle fruity, bitter aftertaste.

Silhouette Vanilla Beer – 4.0%

Award winning Ale. SIBA SILVER 2012 in the Speciality Beers Category. A Pale Yellow Ale Made With Polish Marynka Hops. A Session Beer With Vanilla notes on the nose and palate, with a smooth bitter aftertaste.

Marmalady Orange Beer - 4.8%

Taste notes unavailable at time of writing.

Apricot Jungle - 4.8%

Made with the English Beata hops, this gives this beer it's unique apricot, honey and almond flavours which then finishes with a pleasant bitterness on the palate.

GREEN JACK - Lowestoft, Suffolk

Light, with grainy citrus & marmalade flavours.

Baltic Trader Imperial Stout - 10.5%

An extra strong Imperial Stout with smooth rich roasted coffee & vanilla flavours.

GREENE KING - Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk

Golden Pride - 8.5%

Deep amber in appearance, Golden Pride is full bodied, of moderate bitterness, moderately hopped and rich in malt. Full flavoured, and reminiscent of sweet orange oil, toasted grains, and bread. Rich malty aromas lead to a similarly styled palate, with an intense finish.

Vintage - 8.5%

Each vintage is a blend of that year's finest malt and hops and, of course, unique yeast, creating a unique limited edition brew.

Portobello Bar

A fine dark mild with a distinctive taste and a delicate aroma dominated by dark and chocolate malt, yet with a definite hint of hops.

Carnival – 4.0%

A well balanced, full bodied golden ale with an underlying herbal hop and bitter linger, tropical fruits and citrus notes.

Old Golden Hen - 4.1%

Brewed using the finest pale malts and the rare Tasmanian Galaxy hop, giving the beer its light golden colour, subtle tropical fruit notes and a deliciously refreshing and smooth finish.

Erasilia - 4.1%

A perfect beer for summer, easy drinking & refreshing with an intense citrus zing.

Old Tripp - 4.3%

The delightful well-hopped premium ale has a clean fresh hop aroma which produces a rich, full flavour.

Abbot Ale – 5.0%

Abbot Ale is a full flavoured, smooth and mature beer. It has masses of ripe fruit characters, a malty richness and a superb hop balance. Brewed with pale crystal and amber malts to give an attractive colour and rich malty tastes.

IPA Reserve - 5.4%

This warming, full bodied ale has a reassuringly rich appearance and a mellow fruit aroma. Grapefruit and orange citrus tones combine with the floral and herbal Styrian Goldings hop variety deliver a reserve ale of exceptional quality with a dry, bitter finish.

GUN DOG - Woodford Halse, Northamptonshire Jack's Spaniels - 3.8%

A careful blend of moreish malt and Cascade hops creates Jack's Spaniels, a delicious Blonde Ale. Throw in a well-balanced nature with a playful, but obedient character and you create the favourite with beer lovers everywhere.

Hot Dog - 3.9%

Uber cool, quintessentially English and ever so popular, Hotdog is everything you'd expect from a Summer Beer. A sweet Golden Ale with a clean citrus hop finish, it delivers the ideal refreshment on a hot day.

Lord Barker - 4.2%

Dark, smooth, rich and moreish, Lord Barker is a true gentleman of the beer world. With a clean, refreshing taste and a hop character that commands respect, it's an English Stout that needs to be savoured with a degree of etiquette.

HACKNEY - Hackney, Greater London Golden Ale – 4.0%

This golden ale is a refreshing and complex version, ideal as a session beer. It has deep flavour characteristics but is light and high in aroma hops.

Best Bitter - 4.4%

Traditional ale inspired by the British classic. A true to style best bitter with a deep full bodied taste.

New Zealand Pale Ale - 4.5%

A fruity pale ale made with a blend of all New Zealand hops including Kohatu, Motueka and Nelson Sauvin. This well balanced beer delivers a hoppy aroma and full, fruity flavour.

American Pale Ale - 4.5%

Darker than some, this beer has a rich malt base giving it a warm amber colour and a delicious body of flavour. Brewed with American Cascade hops, making it refreshing and hoppy.

HADRIAN & BORDER - Newcastle-upon-Tyne, Tyne & Wear

Ginger Beer – 4.0%

An amber coloured beer, slightly sweet with refreshing ginger tones.

____ Jetsam - 4.5%

A pale golden bitter, clean and fresh with a flowery nose and a hoppy palate.

HARVEYS - Lewes, Sussex

IPA - 3.5%

With a delicate grassy and earthy hop aroma, the refreshing bitterness of this beer is balanced by the subtle malt flavours which make for an extremely drinkable pint that has a dry finish and lasting aftertaste.

Wild Hop - 3.7%

Beautifully balanced, but a bit on the wild side! Brewed with the aptly named 'Sussex Hop' – originally discovered growing wild in a hedgerow in Sussex, but now cultivated as a variety in its own right. It is supplemented with Cascade hops grown in the UK.

HEAVY INDUSTRY - Henllan, Clwyd

Diawl Beach - 3.8%

A pale sessionable ale. The blend of Amirillo, Cascade, Citra and Columbus hops mean that this little devil punches way above his weight. A fruity hop bomb.

Electric Mountain - 3.8%

A copper coloured beer, using Marris Otter and crystal malts. Hopped with Czech and German hops for an up front bitterness, citrus notes and a refreshing finish.

Freak Chick - 4.5%

This red malty beer made with Maris Otter and Crystal malts, is given an earthy, spicy and zesty character by a complex blend of five hops that is balanced by the sweetness of the malts. The Freak Chick will come into your house while you're out, replace everything with something identical then slip into the woods to smoke cigarettes with her feet.

High Voltage - 4.5%

An old school blonde IPA with a heavy emphasis on aroma. Using huge amounts of exclusively Hereford Goldings in the brew kettle and dry hopping with it too, this beer packs a hoppy punch. Refreshing in the brewing age of "rock star hops" to see, you just can't keep a good hop down.

Nelson's Eye - 4.5%

A golden ale, using Nelson Sauvin hops for flavour and aroma. This unique hop from New Zealand evokes white grape skins, tropical fruits and citrus.

Collaborator – 5.0%

A very dark red beer with a complex, dark roast malt character from Maris Otter, Crystal and Chocolate malt, sweetness and hints of liquorice, all balanced by a blend of hops that give a spicy, refreshing bitterness.

HEXHAMSHIRE - Hexham, Northumberland Devil's Elbow - 3.6%

A smooth ale with a rounded malty taste. The beer is hopped with Fuggles and contains a generous dollop of amber malt.

Blackhall English Stout – 4.0%

An almost opaque black stout, lots of coffee tones, with a dry, roasty finish.

HIGH HOUSE - Matfen, Northumberland

Auld Hemp - 3.8%

An amber coloured traditional ale, single hopped with Fuggles. This, together with the malt produces a most rewarding session bitter with a slight hint of malt in the finish.

Nel's Best - 4.2%

Golden coloured premium ale, single hopped with Goldings. An easy drinking ale which is not overly bitter and has a slight dry finish.

Black Moss - 4.3%

A dark full bodied quality porter with a lightly roasted aroma, and a smooth bitter chocolate finish. The ale is named after one of the collie dogs that used to work on the farm. It has an ABV of 4.3% and is brewed with farm grown malt, Northumbrian water and English hops.

Nettle Beer - 4.5%

An occasional brew made from farm grown nettles, comfrey and ginger.

Matfen Magic - 4.8%

Brown in colour and hopped with a combination of Fuggles and Bramling Cross, this traditional premium ale has a beautiful aroma of blackcurrants and autumn fruits with malty/chocolate overtones.

HOGS BACK - Tongham, Surrey HBB - 3.7%

A light amber session bitter, biscuity flavour with fragrant hops leading to subtle malty citrus fruits with a long aromatic, hoppy finish with a light malty after-taste.

EXEMPE TEA - 4.2%

Traditional English Ale! Pale brown with a hoppy, and slightly fruity aroma supported by malt in the taste. A well crafted bittersweet beer with a long dry finish.

England's Glory - 4.4%

Strong robust malty tones with slight citrus hints – often described as 'caramel orange'

HOP - 4.4%

A malty, pale golden beer with hints of banana and pineapple, with a good balance of aroma and bittering hops giving a long dry finish with a sense of sweetness.

HOLDENS - Dudley, West Midlands

Black Country Mild - 3.7%

A bold chestnut-red mild with nutty biscuit notes with a delicious hint of chocolate.

HOP STUDIO - Elvington, North Yorkshire

York Quaffing Ale - 3.8%

Deep copper colour, with berry and orange flavours. There's a hint of tangerine in the aroma.

C XP – 4.0%

An extra pale ale full of citrus hop flavours, with an intense creamy but dry bitter finish.

HOPBACK - Downton, Wiltshire

Heracles - 2.8%

Silky, biscuity maltiness, with a delicate citrus flavour. There is a dry, clean bitterness with subtle orange flavours of coriander. Strong in flavour, low in alcohol.

Entire Stout - 4.5%

A rich dark stout with a strong roasted malt flavour and a long, smooth aftertaste. Suitable for vegans.

HUMPTY DUMPTY - Reedham, Norfolk

Lemon & Ginger – 4.0%

An amber crisp ale with a ginger and lemon tang.

ILKLEY - Ilkley, West Yorkshire

Lotus IPA - 5.6%

A gold coloured genuine India Pale Ale with hoppy, lemon and citrus aromas. This ale is complex but well balanced and full of flavour.

ITCHEN VALLEY - Alresford, Hampshire

Pure Gold - 4.8%

A light golden beer. Highly refreshing with initial bitterness from the choicest Czech hops leading to a full, sweet malty flavour.

JENNINGS - Cockermouth, Cumbria

Dark Mild - 3.1%

A very dark malty mild which is characteristically sweet but well balanced and extremely drinkable.

Cumberland Ale – 4.0%

A superb golden coloured ale, brewed with malt made from specially selected Maris Otter barley and using only the finest English hops to impart a delicate aroma.

KELHAM ISLAND - Sheffield, South Yorkshire Riders on the Storm - 4.5%

On the dark side of pale this pleasantly bitter, hoppy, pale ale will take you by the hand....

Mind Control - 6.9%

Double IPA. A mind bending, hypnotic 6.9% Double IPA brewed with a double helping of a trio of the best aroma hops the world has to offer. Citra gives citrus and jasmine, Chinook blackcurrant and elderberry and Nelson Sauvin gives fresh crushed gooseberry. This breath taking plethora of aromas is balanced with tipple and Vienna malts for a completely mesmerising strong pale ale.

LANGHAM - Lodsworth, Sussex

Langham Special Draught - 5.2%

An auburn beer with rich complex flavours and a deep red glow. The sweet maltiness is balanced with spicy hop aromas and a dry finish. Definitely a pint to savour.

LATE KNIGHTS - Penge, Greater London Crack Of Dawn - 3.9%

A crisp hoppy beer with a dry bitter finish. Hops used are Cascade, Saaz and Rewaka.

Hop O' The Morning - 4.2% Well hopped stout.

Morning Glory - 4.4%

Made with both pale and Munich malts to give some caramel notes, there is also some fruit coming through.

Great Exhibition - 4.5%

Beer brewed to a Victorian recipe originally formulated for the Great Exhibition in 1851.

Old Red Eyes - 4.5%

Malty caramelly goodness, double hopped.

Hairy Dog – 6.0%

A single hop, Apollo, black IPA.

LITTLE VALLEY- -Hebden Bridge, West Yorkshire Ginger Pale Ale – 4.0%

Light and fresh with a hint of ginger and citrus. Ginger Pale Ale is approved by the Fairtrade Foundation.

LODDON - Dunsden, Oxfordshire

Bamboozle - 4.8%

A strong pale ale heavily hopped with English Goldings. The Pale ale malt gives the beer a clean and crisp background.

MARSTONS - Burton on Trent, Staffordshire Mew World Pale Ale - 3.8%

New World Pale Ale is a refreshing new beer delivering a blast of tropical tastes that leave a light citrus tingle.

MAULDONS - Sudbury, Suffolk

Silver Adder - 4.2%

Originally brewed to celebrate Mauldons 25 years of brewing. Silver Adder is a light coloured bitter with a fine hop and malt combination giving a refreshing crisp finish.

Blackberry Porter - 4.8%

A full bodied black porter, with a balanced hop aroma and rich blend of chocolate and roast flavours giving way to a subtle sweet fruit finish.

MCMULLEN - Hertford, Hertfordshire

A full bodied classic of a beer. Special

A full bodied classic of a beer. Specially kilned malt is used to give deep rich flavours.

MILESTONE - Newark, Nottinghamshire

Raspberry Wheat - 5.6%

Continental Style Fruit Beer, Mouth filling fruit, with zingy finish.

MONCADA - Notting Hill, Greater London Motting Hill Summer - 3.7%

A refreshing zesty ale that packs a big punch of flavour for its strength. Initially full of hops and bitterness, a subtle sweetness is also present, all leading to a long lingering complex finish.

Notting Hill Blonde - 4.2%

A continental style yellow beer which flavour explodes on the tongue, a mix of hops, bitterness and sweetness. Fruity hops on the nose and palate fade in the aftertaste, leaving a dry bitter character with a little spiciness.

Notting Hill Amber - 4.7%

A full-bodied creamy amber coloured beer with the citrus aroma and flavour well balanced by the sweet slightly toffee maltiness and a bitter dryness that lingers. There is a little flowery hop throughout. Its drinkability belies its strength.

Notting Hill Porter – 5.0%

A strong, easy-drinking, ale with balanced hops, fruit and malt and a long, lingering finish.

MR GRUNDYS - Derby, Derbyshire Lord Kitchener - 5.5%

Full bodied, golden pale. Exciting new world hops give this beer richness of flavour which matches its strength.

NETHERGATE - Cavendish, Suffolk

Lemon Head – 4.0%

Aroma is ginger, with a touch of lemon. Tastes of citrus, spices and herbs, light bitter.

Old Growler – 5.0%

Complex, satisfying porter, smooth and distinctive. Roast malt and fruit feature in the palate. The finish is powerfully hoppy with a hint of liquorice.

NEW PLASSEY - Wrexham, Clwyd

Offa's Dyke - 4.3%

Golden amber colour. The aroma is quite light with flowery and malty notes. The flavour is sweet malty with light and a dryish finish.

Dusky Maiden Stout - 4.4%

A complex superb tasting stout brewed with pale, crystal and chocolate malt with roasted barley.

Deep Porter - 4.5%

A smooth deep brown porter brewed with a variety of coloured malts carefully balanced with Cascade hops.

Cherry Diva - 4.7%

A pale beer with a hint of cherry. Smooth and very drinkable.

NINE STANDARDS - Kirkby Stephen, Cumbria Double Standard Porter - 4.7% A robust porter.

OAKLEAF - Gosport, Hampshire

Over The Top - 5.3%

Taste notes unavailable at time of writing.

OUTSTANDING - Bury, Lancashire

Stout - 5.5%

A true representation of the beer style, Thick, jet black, bitter, with liquorice and strong roast flavours in the finish.

IPA - 7.4%

The unique flavours of this highly complex ale gradually develop and mature over a conditioning process with a duration of several months. The result is a golden, dry and implausibly hopped ale. Relax and take time to savour the intricate flavours of this beer.

PEERLESS - Birkenhead, Merseyside

Oatmeal Stout – 5.0%

Wonderfully smooth and dark. This oatmeal stout has good body, a creamy head and just the right level of sweetness.

PHOENIX - Heywood, Greater Manchester Monkeytown Mild - 3.9% Traditional creamy dark mild.

PORTOBELLO - Notting Hill, Greater London
Bitter - 3.8%

Floral and berry hop characters tickle the nose followed by gentle coffee and roast hazelnut aromas. Smooth in the mouth with more roasted malt and coffee characters and a nice dry, toasted astringency and hint of bitter.

Pale – 4.0%

A golden beer, brewed with marris otter pale ale and caragold malts. With citrus fruit aromas, a smooth, crisp refreshing craft beer.

📃 VPA – 4.0%

A light hand with water treatment, specially selected craft brewing yeast and the use of lightly kilned Maris Otter Pale Ale malt creates VPA's distinctive pale gold colour and an exceptionally clean base allowing the delicate yet distinctive hop characters to be the stars.

Contemporal Star - 4.3%

Brewed with marris otter, caramalt and crystal malts, Portobello Star is a balanced beer with hints of berry fruits and roasted coffee.

POTBELLY - Kettering, Northamptonshire Captain Pigwash Porter – 5.0%

Made from the finest Maris Otter, Chocolate and Crystal malts, together with English hops to give an easy drinking dark porter.

PURPLE MOOSE - Porthmadog, Gwynedd

Snowdonia Ale - 3.6%

A delightfully refreshing pale ale brewed with pale and crystal malt with a delicate combination of Pioneer, Styrian Goldings and Lubelski hops.

Carnival Ale - 4.5%

Imagine a carnival in a beer and you are imagining Carnival Ale. A Golden blonde beer with a complex mango and passionfruit aroma with just a hint of gooseberry. An initial sweetness and full body are balanced by a lasting pink grapefruit bitter finish.

Market Porter - 4.6%

Market Porter's use of Malts, Roasted Barley and Hops produce a beer with malt and hop characters but not excessively bitter. Its aromas are cappuccino, chocolate, dark fruits and vibrant fresh peel. The mouthfeel is velvety and rich, with notes of coffee, chocolate and hazelnuts with warming alcohol and cocoa in the finish.

Pale Ale – 5.0%

Portobello A.P.A. is made from 100% Maris Otter Pale Malt giving a pale-golden, rich malty base to showcase the finest American hops. Cascade and Summit give robust but not excessive bitterness. A rich golden coloured beer produced by blending optic malt, crystal wheat and a small amount of torridied wheat. Added to this are Goldings and Styrian Golding hops which give that distinctly light hoppy aroma and taste.

REBELLION - Marlow, Buckinghamshire

Mild - 3.5%

A traditional dark mild.

— Mutiny - 4.5%

A reddish coloured full bodied ale with a rich malty flavour and a lasting hop finish.

Forty Niner - 4.9%

Golden ale with a satisfying balance of malt and hops.

Old Thumper - 5.6%

Brew 7 Summer Fruit Blonde - 3.7%

Blonde ale created from premium lager malt which has been lightly bittered and delicately finished with gentle peachy hops.

Ruby Mild - 4.4%

Nutty, rich ruby ale. Stronger than usual for a mild.

Volsung – 5.0%

Pale amber premium ale. Well-balanced malt and zingy citrus hops with a full-bodied, complex finish.

SALAMANDER - Bradford, West Yorkshire

Mudpuppy - 4.2%

An amber coloured premium ale, malty flavour with a hoppy character.

SALOPIAN - Shrewsbury, Shropshire

Hop Twister - 4.5%

A rich gold coloured ale, The palate is fresh, piercing and focused, with soft malt overtones and pronounced citrus flavours. A strong focus of taut, lemony, grapefruit on the finish which is balanced by a dry bitterness.

A traditional recipe using time honoured English ingredients such as Kentish hops combined with Maris Otter malts give this ale its thirst quenching, copper coloured, session beer characteristics and good head.

Skidmark - 4.2%

With the formulation of three types of hops, this beer has a perfectly balanced flavout, a fruity, floral aroma and a citrus taste. The blend of malts gives this beer a lovely deep red colour.

Chequered Flag - 4.5%

Darker in colour, this beer has a malty taste with chocolate undertones.

SIREN CRAFT - Finchampstead, Berkshire

Undercurrent - 4.5%

A pale ale with spicy, grassy aromas and lemon zest with a taste of grapefruit and apricot.

Sound Wave - 5.5%

An American style west coast IPA. Golden, immensely hoppy and with grapefruit, peach and mango flavours.

SKINNERS - Truro, Cornwall

Ginger Tosser - 3.8%

A lovely hoppy golden ale fused with Cornish Honey to give this session beer a superb round finish with a hint of ginger. Designed for red-headed pancake tossers (of course! What did you think the name was referencing.... for shame!).

Heligan Honey – 4.0%

A light refreshing bitter, pale amber in colour with distinct hoppy overtones. The subtle addition of real Cornish honey will give your palate a buzzz.

SONNET 43 - Coxhoe, Durham

Steam Beer Amber Ale - 3.8%

An amber ale with excellent clarity and a creamy off-white head with a very good retention period. The aroma has a well-balanced malt and hop combo with sourdough and nut notes. The taste is exactly what you'd expect from pale malt and Northdown hops making this beer medium bodied but with a slightly bitter though very refreshing aftertaste.

📃 IPA - 4.4%

A complex aroma using Goldings hops. Delicate fruity flavours. A very palatable, slightly bitter drink..

American Pale Ale - 5.4%

An interpretation of a classic style. It has a pale bronze colour and an exceptionally full-bodied complex character with a spicy and peppery aroma. Generous quantities of premium Cascade, Simcoe, Centennial and Mount Hood hops give this Pale Ale its fragrant bouquet with a fruity, malty and spicy flavour.

STOD FOLD - Halifax, West Yorkshire Gold - 3.8%

Golden in colour with a light, bitter finish.

THREE B'S - Blackburn, Lancashire

Honey Bee - 3.7%

Golden honey beer. Honey is apparent in both aroma and taste but does not overwhelm.

TINY REBEL - Newport, Gwent

Hank - 4%

Lite US style pale ale with tropical & citrus aromas with low to medium bitterness. Floral flavours with slight caramel and biscuit notes leave the beer well balanced and highly drinkable

C XLPA - 4.2%

An experimental beer using the newly developed Extra Light Pale Malt that gives this beer it's amazing colour. Big American hops are used to balance out the malty base.

TIRRIL - Long Marton, Cumbria

Brougham Ale - 3.9%

Gently hopped with aromatic Goldings, an amber bitter and proving a tremendous hit on its first trials. Pronounced 'Broom' this beer takes its name from Tirril Brewery's original home in Brougham Hall, England's largest country house restoration project.

TITANIC - Burslem, Staffordshire

Cappuccino Stout - 4.5%

The combination of the brewer's and the barista's talents this fabulous beer combines the original dry

Titanic Stout with the flavours of warm, enveloping smooth cappuccino.

Plum Porter - 4.9%

This beer is dark, strong and well rounded; the richness of such a rotund beer is brought to an even keel by the late addition of Goldings hops and natural plum flavouring.

Nine Tenths Below - 5.9%

Indian Pale Ales were sent to the troops at the height of the British Empire, the alcohol preserving the beer during the long voyage. This honey golden beer delights the palate with initial sweetness that rapidly fades as the powerful citrus hops take over. Clean and refreshing in taste above the waterline the boldness and strength lurks beneath!

Yankie Diver – 4.2%

TWICKENHAM - Twickenham, Middlesex

Mosaic Pale - 3.2%

A light session American Pale Ale, heavily hopped with Mosaic providing strong tropical fruit and citrus aromas. A late dry hopping with Citra adds a burst that means this beer is lower in alcohol but high in taste.

Sundancer - 3.7%

A crisp and hoppy session bitter. Amber malt provides a pleasant biscuity edge to this pale golden coloured ale. A blend of British and American hops add a wonderfully floral and citruslike, long dry finish.

Grandstand - 3.8%

A well-hopped and well balanced, brownish amber refreshing session beer. Refreshing, with light citrus hoppy notes and a fresh clean finish.

Redhead - 4.1%

Strong, well-hopped ale. Powerful golden coloured beer. A skillful blend of American hops makes this a beer to be reckoned with. Fruity, citrus nose and flavour.

TWO COCKS - Enborne, Berkshire

Diamond Lil - 3.2%

A deliciously light and fruity golden ale which was developed especially for last year's Jubilee. Swap two cocks for two corgis and you have a brew fit for the Queen.

1643 Cavalier - 3.8%

A light, refreshing, thirst-quenching golden ale. The crisp combination of hops including Styrian Goldings make it an easy drinking ale.

1643 Roundhead - 4.2%

A full bodied, smooth best bitter. The blend of Cascade and First Gold hops gives its characteristic complex hoppiness. A solid, down to earth ale with no airs and graces.

1643 Puritan - 4.5%

The stark black and white appearance conceals luxurious notes of caramel and chocolate. Anything but austere, Cromwell would not approve.

1643 Viscount - 5.6%

An unusual light golden ale that crosses the boundaries of beer / wine / cider in taste. The lightest of malts combined with the scarce Nelson Sauvin hop deliver an ale that marries very low bitterness with a complex fruit character.

VALE - Brill, Buckinghamshire

C Telstar - 3.9%

A tawny ale with a hoppy kick.

Black Swan Mild - 3.9%

Dark and smooth with an impressive full roast flavour that belies its strength.

Red Kite – 4.0%

Red Kite is a refreshing Chestnut Red beer with a bitter finish. Maris Otter Crystal, Chocolate and roasted barley provide a full body whilst Northdown, Fuggle, Williamette and Brewers Gold hops combine to offer a subtle starting bitterness with a strong bitter finish.

Cravitas - 4.8%

A strong, pale ale packed with hop and citrus flavours, rounded off by a dry malty biscuit finish. A pronounced hop aroma throughout.

WEIRD BEARD - Hanwell, Middlesex

Black Perle - 4.5%

This milk stout is chock full of roasty malts, milk sugar, hopped with hand full's of perle plundered from the unsuspecting and aged on a chest full of Zamorana coffee beans.

Mariana Trench - 5.3%

Pacific Northwest meets Pacific Southeast as the best of American and New Zealand hops meld together with just enough malt backbone to allow them to sing. A riot of mango and passion-fruit on the nose but balanced enough to drink by the bucketful.

Hit the Lights - 5.9%

A clean, bitter IPA with loads of fruity hop character.

5 O'Clock Shadow – 7.0%

A dry hopped IPA made with pale, light crystal and Munich malts and Summit, Apollo, Columbus and Cascade hops.

Fade to Black – 7.0%

A Black India Pale Ale with fruity hops, dark toasted notes from the malt and the spicy rye. Grains: Pale,

Crystal, Crystal Rye, Chocolate, Caraffa III. Hops: Summit, Citra, Sorachi Ace.

WHITE PARK - Cranfield, Bedfordshire

White Gold - 3.8%

Aromatic hop aroma, light bitterness, grassy and fresh.

WILD WEATHER - Silchester, Hampshire

Sundowner - 3.4%

A light golden ale with subtle floral and fruity notes perfect for summer or any daze.

Big Muddy - 3.8%

A tawny ale where a smooth malty bitterness combines with floral spicy and mild citrus hoppy overtones.

Black Night - 3.9%

A fabulously dark ale. Enjoy the smooth drinking complex balance of rich malt and hop flavours. Perfect for putting the world to rights.

Little Wind - 4.2%

A deep amber ale with a touch of copper where lovely hop flavours dance on the lingering malty base.

Stormbringer - 4.5%

A deep golden ale which delivers a smooth, distinctive hoppy base with a lovely rich flavour balance and a subtle hint of citrus.

Shepherds Warning - 5.6%

A pale IPA where the flavour begins soft and smooth building to a wonderfully big hit of hoppy grapefruit, peach and mango.

WILLIAMS - Kelliebank, Clackmannanshire Juniper Tree – 3.7%

Flavoured with Juniper berries. Starts with a tart berry note which goes to produce a dry and bitter finish.

Profanity Stout – 7.0%

Black in colour with full, floral, fruity aromas and a huge roasted malt character that gives way to a profanely dry hopped finish.

WINDSOR & ETON - Windsor, Berkshire Parklife - 3.2%

A light, refreshing ale with a surprisingly full body and hop character for its relatively low alcohol.

Knight of the Garter - 3.8%

Straw-coloured Golden Ale. Easy summer drinking with a distinctive fresh citrus hop aroma.

Windsor Knot – 4.0%

Windsor Knot is made with the finest natural ingredients including two specially selected hops, Sovereign and Nelson Sauvin.

Guardsman - 4.2%

Copper-coloured session strength ale with a tangy taste, smoothed by oak conditioning and a really fresh hop. It is brewed with premium Maris Otter pale malt and a blend of Pilgrim, Styrian Golding and Fuggles hops.

Eton Boatman - 4.3%

Made with a combination of American Cita hops, producing citrus flavours, and Australian Galaxy hops giving hints of exotic fruit with a fresh, clean and full flavoured taste.

Conqueror – 5.0%

A black IPA, Conqueror is a rich, complex and very distinctive ale.

WOLF - Attleborough, Norfolk

Norfolk Lavender Honey - 3.7%

Honey infused with lavender is added during the brewing process to give this beer a delicate yet moreish flavour.

XT - Long Crendon, Buckinghamshire

🔲 π (Pi) - 3.142%

A transcendental mild, with an irrational, never ending, depth of roasty flavours. Works out perfectly.

An amber beer with a special Belgian malt and a fruity mix of American and European hops.

A refreshing golden ale made with English Pale and Munich Malts, combined with Czech hops to give a real international flavour.

Apricot Pale - 4.3%

FESTIVAL SPECIAL - A lightly hopped beer, brewed with whole apricots.

Blackcurrant Blonde - 4.3%

FESTIVAL SPECIAL - A blackcurrant beer brewed specially for this festival.

6 - 4.5%

Beautiful ruby red beer, malty and smooth with a cascade hop finish.

8 - 4.5%

A smooth rich dark beer brewed with a careful blend of four malts along with a cocktail of hops to give a complex taste. Deep malty base with dark roasty chocolate flavours, very balanced beer.

13 Pacific Red Ale - 4.5%

Galaxy, Riwaka, Columbus and Pacific Gem Hops from all around the Pacific Ocean, meet on a raft of Amber Red Malts.

14 Pale Saison - 4.5%

A Golden Pale Ale - brewed with a semi wild Belgian Saison Yeast. A zesty fruity refreshing ale with a natural haze.

5 - 5.5%

Big American sized portions of hops on a deep filled malty base.

XPA - 5.9%

An IPA brewed with crisp, clean extra pale malts and numerous North American flavouring and aromatic hop additions. XPA will satisfy the demands of hop hungry colonists.

YEOVIL - Yeovil, Somerset

Stout Hearted - 4.3%

A smooth, dark beer bursting with full bodied rich roast flavours. The maltiness is balanced by late hopping, achieving a truly special stout.
