UK Draught Beers

Welcome to the UK real ale bar.

This year we will have more beers than ever before at Ealing Beer Festival, more than 350 at time of writing, although this is always subject to last minute changes. There should be something to suit all tastes, with beers ranging from 2.5% ABV all the way up to 10.5%. As ever, the range is a variety of returning friends and new faces making their Ealing debut.

For the first time ever at Ealing Beer Festival, we will have beers from Ealing. The Ealing Park Tavern is now brewing their own beers under the Longarm name and will be represented by three beers. Other local brews will be Aeronaut and Dragonfly from Acton and the ever popular Weird Beard from Hanwell. From south of the river, we will have beer from the new Kew Brewery at, erm, Kew.

The past few years have seen an explosion in the number small breweries starting up, not least in London. We be featuring a few of the London ones but not going overboard on it. There will also be several from both Kent and the West Country.

You may notice that we have quite a lot of beers from Twickenham Fine Ales. In fact it will be the largest number of their beers ever assembled in one place.

Once again, our friends at XT have produced a special beer for the festival. As has now become the tradition, it will be a fruit beer. This year, cherries got the nod.

Fruit beers are increasingly popular at Ealing Beer Festival, we have crammed in as many as we can

Strong Ale (5.0% and over)

but have had to stretch the definition of "fruit" in a number of cases – nettles, anyone?

Following requests in previous years, a couple of gluten free beers have been included. As chance would have it, these are at opposite ends of the, rather long, bar.

A few words on how it all works. The beers are arranged roughly alphabetically across three bars, each of which is named for one our friends in breweryland. A few may appear in odd places, often because they were late replacements so a little juggling may be required. We do not hold beer back. Once one becomes drinkable it will display an A4 label, an indication that it is available. The labels come in a variety of colours, roughly matching the dots you will find in the tasting notes which follow and indicating which style of beer lurks within. There is a key below.

Finally. A quick word of thanks all of those involved in the whole process of selecting, ordering, preparing and serving the real ales at Ealing Beer Festival's 26th incarnation. All are volunteers and without them it simply wouldn't happen.

Finally finally, another word of thanks to all of you, who turn up and drink the beer for us. You are the whole point of the festival and I hope you have a great time.

Caillie - 3.8%

Pale & Golden with a subtle malt background and a long lasting citrus hop bitterness. Smooth and refreshing with lots of condition.

CANTERBURY ALES - Chartham, Kent

Wife of Bath's Ale - 3.9%

A golden beer with strong bitterness and grapefruit hop character leading to a long, dry, finish.

The Miller's Ale - 4.2%

A rich red bitter with toffee malts, rich fruity hops and a smooth bitter finish.

CANTERBURY BREWERS - Canterbury, Kent Streetlight Porter - 5.8%

A light session beer with our usual dose of aromatic hops. Well balanced and highly drinkable this beer is the Swanscombe Man's favourite brew, which is why it was named after the Palaeolithic Era. Sweet malts balance out the Grapefruit and Citrus from the US Amarillo and Cascade hops to give an easy drinking session pale ale.

Citra - 4.1%

A hoppy pale ale with a straightforward malt character that really lets the citrus flavours from US Citra hops shine through. A refreshing session beer for summer days.

Neanderthal - 4.4%

The Neanderthal remembers when Best Bitter was the best. This beer is our recollection of that, full of roast and caramel malt flavours and traditional Kent hops. A better Best Bitter.

Shatkora IPA - 5.5%

An IPA made with Shatkora fruit. No? Me neither!

COACH HOUSE - Warrington, Cheshire

Banoffee - 4.2%

A medium-coloured golden brew, with a finely balanced addition of Goldings hops, and redolent of the flavour and aroma of banana and toffee.

Blueberry – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of blueberry.

Raspberry – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of raspberry.

Cranberry – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of cranberry.

Pineapple – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of pineapple.

Passion Fruit – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of passion fruit.

Strawberry – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of strawberry.

Pink Grapefruit – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of pink grapefruit.

Cherry - 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of cherry.

Coconut - 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of coconut.

COASTAL - Redruth, Cornwall

Merry Maidens Mild – 4.0%

A classic dark mild with a good chocolate malt flavour

Erosion – 8.0%

Memorable strong ale with complex roast malt and hop flavours and a moorish smack. After aroma promising caramel this powerful, warming dark old ale bursts with molasses and roast malt. Deep ruby coloured

CONWY - Conwy, Gwynedd

Honey Fayre - 4.5%

"Cwrw Mel". A golden beer with initial honey aromas rounded off by a dry bitter finish.

COTLEIGH - Wiveliscombe, Somerset

Honey Buzzard - 4.5%

A copper coloured ale infused with local Wiveliscombe honey. A smooth, creamy, chocolate palate giving a subtle bitter-sweet finish.

COTSWOLD SPRING - Chipping Sodbury,

Gloucestershire

Ambler - 3.8%

Malty aromas and taste give way to dried fruit and hop flavours. Finishes with slight astringency.

Codger - 4.2%

A dry, crisp, amber, perfectly balanced beer with a mild hoppy finish.

DARK STAR - Partridge Green, Sussex

— Hophead - 3.8%

An extremely clean-drinking pale golden ale with a strong floral aroma and elderflower notes from the Cascade hops. This beer is full-bodied and full-flavoured yet gentle enough to make it a favourite session beer.

Espresso - 4.2%

A black beer brewed with roasted barley malt and challenger hops. Then freshly ground Arabica coffee beans, blended especially for Dark Star, are added to the copper for a few minutes after the boil to provide a rich and complementary coffee aroma.

American Pale Ale - 4.7%

A yeast strain used for the brewing of the pale dry American Ales was specially imported from the USA, along with some Chinook and Centennial hops, to produce this pale ale. The pale Maris Otter malt provides a perfect light colour and dryness to complement the crisp taste and full aroma of the hops.

DENT - Dent, Cumbria

Kamikazi – 5.0%

Hops and fruit dominate this full-bodied gold coloured strong bitter, with pleasant dry bitterness growing in the aftertaste. Citrus and honey in the aroma, with a hint of spiciness in the taste.

DONNINGTON - Stow-on-the-Wold,

Gloucestershire

BB - 3.6%

A pleasant amber bitter with a slight hop aroma, a good balance of malt and hops in the mouth and a bitter aftertaste.

Gold – 4.0%

This award-winning beer has a golden colour with a citrus flavor followed by a rounded malt finish.

SBA - 4.4%

Malt dominates over bitterness in the subtle flavour of this premium bitter, which has a hint of fruit and a dry, malty finish.

DRAGONFLY - Acton, Greater London

2 O'Clock Ordinary – 4.0%

A full-flavoured best bitter with notes of caramel and nuts

Dark Matter - 4.3%

A rich stout with a smooth mouthfeel and dark malt flavours.

Early Doors - 4.3%

A golden hoppy pale ale with a crisp bitterness.

American Red – 4.8%

Deep red with a tight amber head, there is a complex and dry malt profile with a medium lingering bitterness and flavours of lychee and peach.

DRYGATE - Glasgow, Strathclyde
Seven Peaks IPA - 5.0%

Tasting notes unavailable at time of writing.

ELLAND - Elland, West Yorkshire

1872 Porter - 6.5%

Rich, complex and dark Porter from an original 1872 recipe, with an old port nose, and coffee and bitter chocolate flavours on the palate.

ENVILLE - Stourbridge, West Midlands
Cherry Blonde - 4.2%

A light blonde bitter delicately infused with essence of Cherry to produce a Belgian style fruit flavoured beer. The aroma and taste surpass expectation whilst the bitter finish is dry, hoppy and refreshing.

FIREBRAND - Altarnun, Cornwall

Graffiti IPA – 5.0%

Smooth malty body from the finest English malt, hopped profusely with Cascade & Centennial hops, before being dry hopped with bags of Centennial & Motueka. Loads of fruity hoppy flavour with an easy drinkability.

FORGE - Hartland, Devon

Discovery - 3.8%

A golden, hoppy ale.

Devon Maid – 4.0%

A copper coloured ale with a fresh citrus nose, fruity flavours with a powerful hoppy finish that leaves you wanting more.

Handsome - 5.1%

A light brown, well-balanced, hoppy beer.

GEMSTONE - Maidstone, Kent

Sapphire Blonde – 4.0%

Lashings of late hopping by Hercules, Perle and Mittelfrau hops gives this lager coloured ale a hint of pepper along with its citrus flavoured roots.

Diamond IPA – 5.0%

Traditional full flavoured IPA

GRAFTON - Worksop, Nottinghamshire
Framboise Raspberry Beer – 4.0%

Pale ale with the addition of raspberries which gives a zesty, citrus aroma and a subtle fruity, bitter aftertaste.

Lady Ruby - 4.5%

A ruby coloured ale. Fruity on the nose with an initial bitterness on the palate which leads to a cherry explosion on the back of the tongue.

Marmalady Orange Beer - 4.8%

Apricot Jungle - 4.8%

Made with the English Beata hops, this gives this beer its unique apricot, honey and almond flavours which then finishes with a pleasant bitterness on the palate.

GREAT HECK - Great Heck, North Yorkshire

Dave - 3.8%

A smooth, very dark velvety bitter made with finest Maris Otter malted barley and copious quantities of chocolate and crystal malts.

Blonde - 4.3%

Zesty pale ale with Fuggles hops, late hopped with Aurora.

Citra - 4.5%

Golden ale single hopped with Citra.

Treasure IPA - 4.8%

This golden IPA has low to moderate bitterness and very distinctive tropical fruit notes from the premium American hops used in its production. Smooth, hoppy goodness.

Shankar IPA - 5.9%

Pale IPA with good bitterness using lots of American Columbus, Chinook, Cascade and Citra for flavour and aroma and dry hopped during fermentation with Columbus, Willamette and Cascade.

Yakima IPA - 7.4%

Strong IPA with a blend of US hops – Citra, Simcoe, Cascade, Chinook and Amarillo.

GREAT YORKSHIRE - Pickering, North Yorkshire Chocolate Orange – 6.0%

Rich chocolate stout with orange.

GREEN JACK - Lowestoft, Suffolk

Orange Wheat - 4.2%

Light, with grainy citrus & marmalade flavours.

Baltic Trader Imperial Stout - 10.5%

An extra strong Imperial Stout with smooth rich roasted coffee & vanilla flavours.

GREENE KING - Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk

XX Mild - 3.0%

A fine dark mild with a distinctive taste and a delicate aroma dominated by dark and chocolate malt, yet with a definite hint of hops.

Old Golden Hen - 4.1%

Brewed using the finest pale malts and the rare Tasmanian Galaxy hop, giving the beer its light golden colour, subtle tropical fruit notes and a deliciously refreshing and smooth finish.

St Edmunds - 4.2%

St Edmunds is a fresh, golden beer with a citrus finish, brewed using pale malt and cascade hops. Crafted for modern tastes using traditional brewing methods, this is the perfect introduction to real beer.

Abbot Ale – 5.0%

Abbot Ale is a full flavoured, smooth and mature beer. It has masses of ripe fruit characters, a malty richness and a superb hop balance. Brewed with pale crystal and amber malts to give an attractive colour and rich malty tastes.

RumRunner - 5.2%

A rum infused beer with authentic Jamaican rum for a full flavour of the Caribbean! The RumRunner is the name traditionally used for the ships sailed by pirates smuggling alcohol illegally to avoid tax.

GYLE 59 - Thorncombe, Dorset

Freedom Hiker - 3.7%

Created in honour of the Tolpuddle Pilgrimage, this beer is based on a recipe that was brewed during the period when the Tolpuddle Martyrs were deported to Australia. In addition to the UK hops and malt that form the traditional body of this beer we have added an extra aroma hop grown in Australia. The beer is golden brown with a rich amber malt flavour combining with New World hops to put a modern twist on an old recipe. Brewed to a lower strength than the original recipe, this beer is a refreshing drink for a weary pilgrim.

Happy Daze - 4.1%

A classic and refreshing wheat beer. A hit of banana and spice from the yeast and subtle addition of coriander make put this beer in a class of its own.

Nettle Beer - 5.3%

An annual special originally made for the Nettle Eating Competition held at the Bottle Inn, just up the lane from the brewery.

Dorset GIPA - 5.4%

This is a Ginger IPA. The beer has a subtle infusion

of root ginger giving the IPA a refreshing and spicy addition to the citrus and floral taste and aroma provided by the hops.

The Favourite - 6.6%

A robust and fruity porter. Heavily hopped with Bramling Cross and Brewers Gold, it has a flavour and aroma which reminds you of dark fruits such as black cherries and blackcurrants. The rich mix of chocolate, black and crystal malts ensure that the taste of the hops are enhanced by a contrasting dark chocolate and roasted malt flavour.

Starstruck - 6.6%

This is their porter, The Favourite, enhanced with a subtle addition of star anise. This addition gives the rich and fruity porter an extra complexity with a gentle hint of liquorice.

HACKNEY - Hackney, Greater London

Golden Ale – 4.0%

This golden ale is a refreshing and complex version, ideal as a session beer. It has deep flavour characteristics but is light and high in aroma hops.

Best Bitter - 4.4%

Traditional ale inspired by the British classic. A true to style best bitter with a deep full bodied taste.

Kiwi Pale Ale - 4.5%

A fruity pale ale made with a blend of New Zealand hops. This well balanced beer delivers a hoppy aroma and full, fruity flavour.

American Pale Ale - 4.5%

Darker than some, this beer has a rich malt base giving it a warm amber colour and a delicious body of flavour. Brewed with American Cascade hops, making it refreshing and hoppy.

An amber coloured beer, slightly sweet with refreshing ginger tones.

HARBOUR - Trekillick, Cornwall

Light - 3.7%

Refreshing, light golden ale packed with citrus hops all the way through. Some bitterness and dryness in the finish.

Pale Ale – 6.0%

Citrus and tropical fruit characters with some malt notes and a dry finish.

HART - Preston, Lancashire

Pale Ale - 3.8%

HPA! A light golden session beer using German Munich malts, blended with StyrianGolding hops to produce a nice balanced hoppy taste.

HARVEYS - Lewes, Sussex

Dark Mild – 3.0%

A dark traditional mild ale. Well balanced beer with a soft, slightly sweet palate.

☐☐ IPA - 3.5%

With a delicate grassy and earthy hop aroma, the refreshing bitterness of this beer is balanced by the subtle malt flavours which make for an extremely drinkable pint that has a dry finish and lasting aftertaste.

Best Bitter – 4.0%

A full, well-hopped bitter with a reputation that exceeds the borders of its native and adjoining counties.

HARVIESTOUN - Alva, Clackmannanshire Schiehallion - 4.8%

The original cask conditioned lager beer Schiehallion is crisp, dry and airy with a beautifully fresh, grapefruity taste. Delicately crafted using Hersbrucker lager hops; it is fermented at a very low temperature with lager yeast.

HASTINGS - Hastings, Sussex
Mosaic Pale - 4.8%

This beer has a fruity, spicy aroma and is made from Mosaic hops.

HEXHAMSHIRE - Hexham, Northumberland
Shire Bitter - 3.8%

A golden hoppy bitter with a malty biscuit overtone— very moreish. Caramalt together with Goldings hops supplies a clean taste sensation.

Devil's Water - 4.1%

Malty dark ale with a fruity range of flavours. Crystal malt, roasted barley, Fuggles and Goldings hops contribute to a full taste.

HIGHLAND - Swannay, Orkney

Sneeky Wee Orkney Stout - 4.2%

Perfectly conditioned and mostly El Dorado hops.

HOGS BACK - Tongham, Surrey

A light amber session bitter, biscuity flavour with fragrant hops leading to subtle malty citrus fruits with a long aromatic, hoppy finish with a light malty after-taste.

A recently launched full strength complex IPA.

HOP FUZZ - Hythe, Kent

Yellow Zinger - 3.7%

Summer session ale, made using three of the most citrusy hops around. Great for a 1st refreshing pint, dangerously drinkable!

Northern Star - 4.4%

Traditional style English best bitter finished with honey. Clear pale brown lasting beige head. Decent malt. Bit nutty with some hop on the finish.

HOP STUDIO - Elvington, North Yorkshire

Clean malty base topped with an explosion of grapefruit and tropical fruit flavours. Big aroma.

HOPBACK - Downton, Wiltshire Crop Circle - 4.2%

A very clean, flaxen-coloured beer with wonderful thirst-quenching properties. The subtle blend of aroma and bittering hops give a crispness on the tongue which is delicately fruity, giving way to some dryness. The inclusion of flaked maize in the grist subtly hints at crisp corn flavours.

Entire Stout - 4.5%

A rich dark stout with a strong roasted malt flavour and a long, smooth aftertaste. Suitable for vegans.

HOPDAEMON - Newnham, Kent Green Daemon - 5.0%

A golden beer with luscious tropical fruit aromas and a crisp clean finish.

HUMPTY DUMPTY - Reedham, Norfolk

Lemon & Ginger – 4.0%

An amber crisp ale with a ginger and lemon tang.

HUNTERS - Ippleden, Devon

Pheasant Plucker - 4.3%

A warm, rounded yet surprisingly delicate dark strong ale with a luscious balance of grain and hop in the mouth, bitter sweet finish with delicate caramel taste. The aroma is spicy with hint of

Black Jack - 6.0%

Premium strong but light stout that is well balanced with a caramel undertone. Triple hopped using mainly a Boadecia hop with a late addition of Bramley cross adding a refreshing hop aroma.

ISCA - Dawlish, Devon

Dawlish Summer - 3.8%

Light beer with a hoppy aroma.

Dawlish Bitter - 4.2%

Classic English bitter full of English hops and west coutry malt.

Holcombe Gold - 4.5%

Golden beer full of English and American hops leading to a dry bitter finish.

ITCHEN VALLEY - Alresford, Hampshire

Pure Gold - 4.8%

A light golden beer. Highly refreshing with initial bitterness from the choicest Czech hops leading to a full, sweet malty flavour.

JENNINGS - Cockermouth, Cumbria

Dark Mild - 3.1%

A very dark malty mild which is characteristically sweet but well balanced and extremely drinkable.

KELHAM ISLAND - Sheffield, South Yorkshire

Riders on the Storm - 4.5%

On the dark side of pale this pleasantly bitter, hoppy, pale ale will take you by the hand....

Mr Red – 6.0%

A dangerously crafted red ale with a toasted malt character and deep red hue. The hop flavour is robust and fruity from an all American blend with aromas of grapefruit, passion fruit and pine.

Sessionable amber ale. Hoppy, malty and easy drinking.

Chocolate Milk Stout – 4.0%

A rich bittersweet stout made with 6 different grains, lactose and real chocolate. The big taste of this beer belies its low ABV of 4%.

Sandycombe Gold - 4.4%

Hoppy, refreshing golden ale.

Pagoda Pale - 4.4%

One of a series of pale ales showcasing different English hops.

KEYSTONE - Berwick St Leonard, Wiltshire

Gold Spice – 4.0%

A light-coloured, well hopped beer with stem ginger added to the cask.

KINGS - Horsham, Sussex

Lost Kingdom IPA - 5.2%

IPA has a deep colour which is reminiscent of the new world IPAs, but do not be fooled, this is a solidly English style IPA. There's orangey fruit on the nose and distinct hops presaging flavours to come. Birdie Flipper - 4.5%

This rebellious, full bodied Birdie Flipper is going to get them raging. Pacific hops, wheat, and roasted barley pack this aromatic red ale full of interesting flavours and aromas.

IPA-OK - 5.5%

New generation IPA with bitter taste and long hoppy finish. It is meant for younger crowd that can appreciate full hoppy flavours and hoppy bitterness.

RINGWOOD - Ringwood, Hampshire

Forty Niner - 4.9%

Golden ale with a satisfying balance of malt and hops.

ROBINSONS - Stockport, Cheshire

Trooper - 4.8%

A premium British beer created by rock band Iron Maiden and handcrafted at Robinsons Brewery, a beer which has true depth of character. Malt flavours and citric notes from a unique blend of Bobec, Goldings and Cascade hops dominate this deep golden ale with a subtle hint of lemon.

Double Hop IPA - 4.8%

A rich golden, bitter beer with a refreshing and complex palate and a crisp, dry roasted malt finish.

Old Tom - 8.5%

Dark, smooth, rich and warming superior barley wine with a dark winey colour.

ROCKIN ROBIN - Boughton Manchelsea, Kent Rock a Hula – 4.0%

A new world pale ale, tropical and tantalising.

Really Rockin – 5.0%

A classic, full-bodied ale. Dry hopped to deliver tropical fruit flavours.

ROOSTERS - Knaresborough, North Yorkshire
High Tea - 6.2%

Originally brewed with beer writer Melissa Cole as a

one-off, High Tea is a limited edition Jasmine Green Tea IPA, brewed in collaboration with Taylors of Harrogate, a family-owned tea merchant responsible for some of the best-loved teas in Britain. Simpson's Golden Promise pale malt provides a backdrop for a blend of four hops, jasmine flowers and Taylors' Green Tea with Jasmine, creating a mixed-fruit and floral aroma, with a balanced bitterness and green tea finish. English Admiral hops have been used to provide a citrus backbone to the beer, whilst the addition of three New World hops (Cascade, Crystal and Galaxy) enhances the fruit and jasmine aromas.

RUDGATE - Tockwith, North Yorkshire

Ruby Mild - 4.4%

Nutty, rich ruby ale. Stronger than usual for a mild.

SADLERS - Stourbridge, West Midlands

Boris Citrov - 4.7%

An orange marmalade ale with a sweet, crisp and fruity finish.

SALTAIRE - Shipley, West Yorkshire

Elderflower Blonde – 4.0%

A refreshing Blonde ale infused with the delicate flavour of elderflower.

Raspberry Blonde – 4.0%

Refreshing blonde ale delicately infused with raspberry flavours.

Blackberry Cascade - 4.8%

American style pale ale, hopped with Cascade and Centennial hops. Infused with a hint of blackberries.

SHEPHERD NEAME - Faversham, Kent

Master Brew - 3.7%

A clean, dry, refreshing, session bitter, having a touch of sweetness, but displaying an assertive and vibrant hop with a lingering bitter finish.

Kent's Best - 4.1%

An ambient bitter, which successfully merges the biscuity sweetness of English malt with the fruity, floral bitterness of locally grown hops from the Kent countryside, to give a clean, satisfying and moreish drink.

Spitfire - 4.2%

Crafted from traditional varieties of English malt, this golden ale combines an underlying depth of maltiness, tinged with a subtle hint of toffee, with the bold citrus and fruity spiciness of Kentish hops, to produce a well-balanced, thirst quenching, popular drink.

SHERFIELD VILLAGE - Sherfield on Lodden, Hampshire

□ TBA - 3.9%

Originally brewed with Reading University Real Ale Society, a copper coloured best bitter brewed with English, American and New Zealand hops.

Single Hop - Green Bullet - 4.3%

Plenty of flavour, with a citrus kick and floral aroma.

Hoppy Harrington - 4.7%

Five-hop special brewed with US, NZ and UK hops for a complex flavour with a sweetish flavour and a satisfying hoppy finish. Mid-brown in colour.

Pioneer Stout – 5.0%

A black, black stout, packed with chocolate malt and Pioneer hops, and a hint of vanilla.

UBIK – 5.0%

Copper coloured best bitter brewed with English, American and New Zealand hops.

SHUGBOROUGH - Milford, Staffordshire

Mi Lady's Fancy - 4.6%

As Spring comes in the great houses and the lambs dance in the country estates a deep stirring occurs in the brewhouse. The brewer turns his skills to produce a golden beer to remind him of the sunshine, delicately hopped yet full bodied to celebrate the growth of another year.

SILVERSTONE - Syresham, Northamptonshire Pitstop - 3.8%

A traditional recipe using time honoured English ingredients such as Kentish hops combined with Maris Otter malts give this ale its thirst quenching, copper coloured, session beer characteristics and good head.

Slipstream - 4.2%

With a formulation of three different hops, this beer has a perfectly balanced flavour, a fruity, floral aroma and a citrusy taste, A refreshing light beer.

Golden Age - 4.7%

Dark brown colour with a dry malty aroma. This carries on into the mouth with a load of toast coming in at the end.

SINCLAIR - Quoyloo, Orkney

Dragonhead Stout – 4.0%

A strong, dark malt aroma flows into the taste of this Scottish stout. The roast malt continues to dominate the aftertaste and blends with chocolate to develop a strong, dry finish.

SKINNERS - Truro, Cornwall Ginger Tosser - 3.8%

A lovely hoppy golden ale fused with Cornish Honey to give this session beer a superb round finish with a hint of ginger. Designed for red-headed pancake tossers (of course! What did you think the name was referencing.... for shame!).

SONNET 43 - Coxhoe, Durham American Pale Ale - 5.4%

An interpretation of a classic style. It has a pale bronze colour and an exceptionally full-bodied complex character with a spicy and peppery aroma. Generous quantities of premium Cascade, Simcoe, Centennial and Mount Hood hops give this Pale Ale its fragrant bouquet with a fruity, malty and spicy flavour.

SPRINGHEAD - Newark, Nottinghamshire

The Leveller - 4.7%

A dark, smoky intense flavour with a burnt toffee finish. Brewed in the style of Belgian Trappist ale.

STOCKLINCH - Stocklinch, Somerset

Ramblers Gold - 3.8%

Refreshing light golden beer with a slight aftertaste of grapefruit.

Rusty Boiler - 4.5%

Mid-brown best bitter. Strong fruity flavours with a hint of caramel.

STONEHENGE - Netheravon, Wiltshire

Great Bustard - 4.8%

Brewed to celebrate the reintroduction of the Great Bustard onto Salisbury Plains. The colour is deep amber with a red hue, the taste is deliciously fruity and malty with a lingering bitter aftertaste.

STRATHAVEN - Strathaven. Strathclyde
Claverhouse - 4.5%

The deep burnished colour originates from a combination of crystal and red malts. Flavoured with a partnership of both British and American hops, the citrus taste is complemented by a blossoming floral aroma.

TIME & TIDE - East Walmer, Kent
Smugglers Stout - 5.2%

A nod to Deal's rich smuggling history, which can be dated back to the mid-18th century, around the same time that 'stout porter' was coined in reference to a strong porter.

Calista IPA - 6.1%

This beer's name is derived from the Greek for 'most beautiful', and for many hop fanatics this IPA truly is!

TITANIC - Burslem, Staffordshire

Mild - 3.5%

A mild of classic style full of roast malt and balanced by delicate hops. True to type it has a rounded sweetness and a smooth dry finish.

Stout - 4.5%

A true old fashioned stout. A dark combination of malt and roast with some hops. Strongly flavoured and well balanced.

Plum Porter - 4.9%

This beer is dark, strong and well rounded; the richness of such a rotund beer is brought to an

even keel by the late addition of Goldings hops and natural plum flavouring.

TOOLMAKERS - Sheffield, South Yorkshire

Split Pin - 3.8%

A pale light hoppy ale made with 4 hops to give a nice dry taste with lots of flavour.

____ Lynch Pin – 4.0%

A sweet tasting bitter / pale ale style beer, easy to drink.

Demand Valve - 4.2%

A nice light hoppy ale full of flavour, made with Chinook, Citra and Hercules hops

Flange Noire - 4.8%

A smooth, smoky stout.

TRIPLE FFF - Alton, Hampshire

Dazed and Confused - 4.6%

A genuine Hampshire pale ale, refreshing and moderately bitter.

TRUMANS - Hackney, Greater London

Swift - 3.9%

Well balanced golden bitter with hops and a trace of grapefruit on the nose and palate and a bitter finish.

Runner – 4.0%

Traditional brown best bitter with spicy hoppy aroma and flavour fading in the dry aftertaste. Some marmalade fruity notes.

Lazarus - 4.2%

Pouring a pale gold, it weighs in at a sprightly 4.2%, making it light enough to sate the thirstiest of drinkers. In essence, Lazarus (named after the biblical character who was raised from the dead) provides the perfect balance between flavour and refreshment.

Zephyr - 4.3%

A brash and bold 'Pacific Pale Ale' packed full of juicy new world Australian hops exclusive to Truman's. Bursting on the nose and palate with ripe melon, apricot and pineapple, this beer has a pithy grapefruit finish with fragrant floral undertones and a delicate caramel sweetness from the malts to give a rounded balance.

TWICKENHAM - Twickenham, Middlesex

Mosaic Pale - 3.2%

A light session American Pale Ale, heavily hopped

with Mosaic providing strong tropical fruit and citrus aromas. A late dry hopping with Citra adds a burst that means this beer is lower in alcohol but high in taste.

Sundancer - 3.7%

A crisp and hoppy session bitter. Amber malt provides a pleasant biscuity edge to this pale golden coloured ale. A blend of British and American hops add a wonderfully floral and citrus-like, long dry finish.

Grandstand - 3.8%

A well-hopped and well balanced, brownish amber refreshing session beer. Refreshing, with light citrus hoppy notes and a fresh clean finish.

Redhead - 4.1%

Roasted barley, along with a blend of pale/dark crystal malts and caramalt give this red hued beer a soft maltiness with roasted notes, whilst the English/German hop mix gives it a spicy hop character.

Naked Ladies - 4.4%

Hoppy beer using Pioneer and Styrian Goldings for full-flavoured satisfaction. Good body and luscious aroma.

Summer Sun - 4.4%

Very pale, very hoppy beer with an excellent flavour. Extra pale ale and wheat malts combine with the aromatic Citra hop to make a very bright and refreshing pint for a warm summer's day.

Gothick Dark - 4.6%

A strong dark mild, brewed using pale crystal and two types of chocolate malt. Full-bodied and malty but with a dry, chocolate edge.

Honey Dark - 4.8%

Strong dark beer. Chocolate, coffee and honey all figure in the aroma and flavour.

London Gold - 4.9%

Big hoppy flavour and nose with juicy malt underpinnings; long pleasing dry hoppy finish. With four American and two British hops, it's a cosmopolitan brew worthy of such a great city.

Nooksack – 5.0%

Twickenham collaboration with Kissingate brewery. A big American pale Ale with hops from Washington state.

Eureka – 5.0%

A collaboration brew with Redemption Brewery of Tottenham. This amber ale is brewed with the experimental hop. Eureka. Hence the name.

Daisy Cutter - 6.1%

Strong, well-hopped ale. Powerful golden coloured beer. A skillful blend of American hops makes this a beer to be reckoned with. Fruity, citrus nose and flavour.

TWO COCKS - Enborne, Berkshire

Diamond Lil - 3.2%

A deliciously light and fruity golden ale which was developed especially for last year's Jubilee. Swap two cocks for two corgis and you have a brew fit for the Queen.

1643 Cavalier - 3.8%

A light, refreshing, thirst-quenching golden ale. The crisp combination of hops including Styrian Goldings make it an easy drinking ale.

1643 Leveller - 3.8%

An unusual selection of malts impart a unique flavour to this session bitter. The complex maltiness is offset by a single variety of Old English hop.

1643 Musket - 3.8%

New World hops combined with an interesting mix of 4 malts and late hopping make this a very smooth, flavour-packed session ale.

1643 Roundhead - 4.2%

A full bodied, smooth best bitter. The blend of Cascade and First Gold hops gives its characteristic complex hoppiness. A solid, down to earth ale with no airs and graces.

1643 Puritan - 4.5%

The stark black and white appearance conceals luxurious notes of caramel and chocolate. Anything but austere, Cromwell would not approve.

1643 Viscount - 5.6%

An unusual light golden ale that crosses the boundaries of beer / wine / cider in taste. The lightest of malts combined with the scarce Nelson Sauvin hop deliver an ale that marries very low bitterness with a complex fruit character.

VALE - Brill, Buckinghamshire

☐ Brill Gold - 3.5%

A golden session ale made from the finest Maris

Otter malted barley and English hops. The full malt flavour is well balanced with fruity, slightly citrus hop aromas and a soft bitterness.

IPA - 3.7%

Light copper in colour, all English, heavily hopped IPA resulting in a thirst quenching beer with a pleasant hop aroma and balanced finish.

Black Swan Mild - 3.9%

Dark and smooth with an impressive full roast flavour that belies its strength.

Wychert Ale - 3.9%

A traditional Thames Valley beer, excellent flavours are notable in this strikingly malty beer. With a finish of fruit and nut on the palate.

Red Kite - 4.0%

Red Kite is a refreshing Chestnut Red beer with a bitter finish. Maris Otter Crystal, Chocolate and roasted barley provide a full body whilst Northdown, Fuggle, Willamette and Brewers Gold hops combine to offer a subtle starting bitterness with a strong bitter finish.

VPA - 4.2%

Hops from across the Atlantic and Kent's finest produce an assertive dry hoppy ale with a citrus nose, combined with a pronounced malt background.

Black Beauty - 4.4%

An award winning wholesome full bodied Porter. Intense malt flavour gives way to a wonderful hop flavour with a pleasant burnt sugar, caramel like character.

Paradise Lost - 4.4%

John Milton's 10 book poem, Paradise Lost describes the fall of mankind and the war between heaven and hell. An epic piece of literature. This golden beer gives a slight nod to the unexpected hero of the story whilst offering a hoppy tropical taste of Paradise Lost.

Gravitas - 4.8%

A strong, pale ale packed with hop and citrus flavours, rounded off by a dry malty biscuit finish. A pronounced hop aroma throughout.

WANTSUM - Hersden, Kent

1381 - 3.8%

The year of the Peasants' Revolt. A golden IPA

combining pale and crystal malts with Willamette and Centenial hops to give delicate citrus and herbal aromas.

Black Prince - 3.9%

The eldest son of Edward III who was married to Joan of Kent a and buried in Canterbury Cathedral. A rich, full bodied Kent mild, smooth on the pallet with subtle hop notes.

Miller's Mirth - 4.2%

Named after the merry Miller from the Canterbury Tales who was always inebriated! A copper coloured best bitter. A blend of smooth toasted malts balance a four hop profile, giving breadth of flavour and depth.

Hengist – 5.0%

Named after the Anglo Saxon invader who formed the Kingdom of Kent. Golden coloured pale ale with flavours of biscuit malt balancing a long fruit hop profile.

WEIRD BEARD - Hanwell, Middlesex

Black Perle – 4.5%

This milk stout is chock full of roasty malts, milk sugar, hopped with handfuls of perle plundered from the unsuspecting and aged on a chest full of Zamorana coffee beans.

Mariana Trench - 5.3%

Pacific Northwest meets Pacific Southeast as the best of American and New Zealand hops meld together with just enough malt backbone to allow them to sing. A riot of mango and passion-fruit on the nose but balanced enough to drink by the bucketful

Decadence Stout - 5.5%

Stouts should be thick and full bodied due to how you brew them, not because you serve them with nitrogen. Get away from the metallic nitro-kegged stouts and have a little bit of decadence in the glass. Multiple grains types and precise brewing leave decadence stout with an opulent mouthfeel and generous head. Rich with chocolate and coffee roast flavours with just a touch of oat creaminess. Treat yourself!

K*ntish Town BearD - 5.5%

Hoppy American wheat beer, originally designed in collaboration with the Brewdog bar in Camden.

Hit the Lights - 5.9%

A clean, bitter IPA with loads of fruity hop character.

5 O'Clock Shadow - 7.0%

A dry hopped IPA made with pale, light crystal and Munich malts and Summit, Apollo, Columbus and Cascade hops.

WENSLEYDALE - Bedale, North Yorkshire Gold - 4.5%

A golden ale combining punchy new world hops and light kilned malt. Aromas are peppery with citrus. Flavours are sweet toffee with dry tea. Peppery, bitter grapefruit towards the finish. Dry aftertaste.

WENTWORTH - Wentworth, South Yorkshire Oyster Stout - 4.8%

Tasting notes unavailable at time of writing.

WESSEX - Longbridge Deverill, Wiltshire

Potter's Ale - 3.8%

A classic bitter.

Longleat Pride – 4.0%

A pale, hoppy bitter.

Russian Stoat – 9.0%

Aroma is treacle, molasses and dark fruit. Flavour is similar but with butterscotch and pear drop dryness. Dry, sweet finish.

WEST BERKSHIRE - Thatcham, Berkshire Maggs Magnificent Mild - 3.8%

A traditional dark mild, not too sweet and very popular.

WHITSTABLE - Grafty Green, Kent

Oyster Stout - 4.5%

Rich, dry, chocolate and mocha flavours.

WICKWAR - Wickwar, Gloucestershire Station Porter - 6.1%

An extremely dark ruby beer with a fruity, chocolaty nose. The taste is smooth, fruity with bitter roast character to balance. Lightish body, roasted, bitter orange finish.

WILLIAMS - Kelliebank, Clackmannanshire Harvest Sun - 3.9%

This is a straight up, honest, working man's ale; brewed to quench the thirst and revive the spirit. Pours a straw gold with a pleasant citrus aroma that

gives way to a balanced and satisfyingly bitter finish.

WINDSOR & ETON - Windsor, Berkshire

Parklife - 3.2%

A light, refreshing ale with a surprisingly full body and hop character for its relatively low alcohol.

Solution Knight of the Garter - 3.8%

Straw-coloured Golden Ale. Easy summer drinking with a distinctive fresh citrus hop aroma.

Magna Carta – 4.0%

A very special beer brewed to commemorate a very special local event. Brewed collaboratively with the London Amateur Brewers, who held a competition for the best recipe for an old English ale. Brewed by the people for the people, it's rich in warming malt flavours but further enhanced by the use of traditional ingredients, including local herbs such as Yarrow, Ground Ivy and some Liquorice. The result is a wonderful, complex beer with rich deep red and dark fruit.

Corker - 4.0%

A light coloured bitter brewed in collaboration with the Sydney-based Australian brewer 4-Pines. Hops from both hemispheres plus Elderflower and Lemon Myrtle make this a summer bitter.

Guardsman - 4.2%

Copper-coloured session strength ale with a tangy taste, smoothed by oak conditioning and a really fresh hop. It is brewed with premium Maris Otter pale malt and a blend of Pilgrim, Styrian Golding and Fuggles hops.

Eton Boatman - 4.3%

Made with a combination of American Citra hops, producing citrus flavours, and Australian Galaxy hops giving hints of exotic fruit with a fresh, clean and full flavoured taste.

Conqueror – 5.0%

A black IPA, Conqueror is a rich, complex and very distinctive ale.

WOLD TOP - Wold Newton, East Yorkshire Against the Grain - 4.5%

GLUTEN FREE. Smooth & creamy, a good head and full flavoured indistinguishable from a normal bitter! Also suitable for vegans.

WOLF - Attleborough, Norfolk

Norfolk Lavender Honey - 3.7%

Honey infused with lavender is added during the brewing process to give this beer a delicate yet moreish flavour

WYCHWOOD - Witney, Oxfordshire

Hobgoblin - 4.5%

Full-bodied and well balanced with a chocolate toffee malt flavour, moderate bitterness and a distinctive fruity character with a ruby red glow.

WYLAM - Heddon on the Wall, Northumberland Red Kite - 4.5%

A ruby ale in the style of a traditional 'scotch' where the hops are balanced by residual maltiness to give a subtle hop character and a rich palate. Brewed to celebrate the re-introduction of the Red Kite to the North East after an absence of 170 years.

XT - Long Crendon, Buckinghamshire

 π (Pi) - 3.142%

A transcendental Mild, with an irrational, never ending depth of roasty flavours. Works out perfectly.

4 - 3.8%

An amber beer with a special Belgian malt and a fruity mix of American and European hops.

2 - 4.2%

A refeshing golden ale made with English Pale and Munich Malts, combined with Czech hops to give a real international flavour.

1 - 4.2%

Citrus and fruity hops flirt with reserved English barley and some very naughty Bohemian malts to make a characterful blonde ale that you'll want to meet again.

1215 Magna Carta - 4.2%

An all English Pale Amber Ale brewed with finest Yorkshire malts, with Goldings, Admiral and Challenger hops from Kent and Herefordshire.

Cherry Beer – 4.2%

FESTIVAL SPECIAL

8 - 4.5%

A smooth rich dark beer brewed with a careful blend of four malts along with a cocktail of hops to

give a complex taste. Deep malty base with dark roasty chocolate flavours, very balanced beer.

14 Pale Saison - 4.5%

A Golden Pale Ale - brewed with a semi wild Belgian Saison Yeast. A zesty fruity refreshing ale with a natural haze.

15 - 4.5%

Brewed to celebrate the new varieties of English Hops. This is an English IPA triple hopped, pale amber ale with caramel malt notes, lasting floral, hop character.

XPA - 5.9%

An IPA brewed with crisp, clean extra pale malts and numerous North American flavouring and aromatic hop additions. XPA will satisfy the demands of hop hungry colonists.

YEOVIL - Yeovil, Somerset

British Summer Time - 4.5%

A zesty pale ale with rounded bitterness and crisp pleasant lemon and grapefruit aromas.

YORKSHIRE HEART - Nun Monkton, North Yorkshire

Rhu Bar Beer - 3.7%

Dark in colour with deliciously fruity Rhubarb flavours complete with a crisp aroma and refreshing tartness aftertaste.

Hearty Mild – 4.0%

Brewed from a traditional recipe using a blend of four malts to give a delightfully smooth drinking ale. This rich flavoured mild has hints of nut and chocolate and has a natural residual sweetness, an easy drinking ale.

Get Pithed Orange Fruit Beer - 4.2%

A fruit beer full of citrus orange flavours creating a refreshing beer perfect for any time of the day.
