You will see from the beer list that beers are listed by brewery in alphabetical order and this will be broadly replicated across the three bars with breweries running alphabetically from left to right across each of the bars. The labels on the end of the casks will indicate the brewery, beer name, ABV of the beer, style and price in 1/3, 1/2 and Pints. To make the style stand out further the labels will be colour coded with the style of beer and will correspond with the colour coding in this programme.

ALLENDALE - Allendale, Northumberland

Wagtail Best Bitter - 3.8%

A traditional Best Bitter. Superbly balanced with a floral hop aroma from Goldings and Fuggles hops.

Pennine Pale - 4.0%

Fruity, floral and aromatic due to Columbus, Cascade and Citra hop additions.

**Wolf - 5.5%** 

A beautiful red coloured, full bodied beer taking its name from the famous wolf of Allendale. With bitterness coming from Challenger hops and a fruity blackcurrant aroma coming from Williamette hops. At 5.5% abv. this really is beer with bite!

ANDWELL - Hook, Hampshire

Resolute Bitter - 3.8%

Andwell's Best Bitter combines the finest malt and hops to produce a well balanced malty and hoppy flavour with a light amber colour.

Gold Muddler - 3.9%

Named after a fishing fly used for luring trout, this blonde ale has a refreshing palate due to the use of high quality pale ale malt. By blending different hops at various stages of the brewing process Andwell have produced a beautiful beer with a citrus aroma and balanced bitterness.

Summer Daze - 4.1%

With moderate bitterness, and a lemongrass / sauvignon aroma from German Hallertau Blanc hops combined with the familiar passion and tropical fruit from a generous dry hopping of Citra.

**King John - 4.2%** 

This pale ale takes its name from the castle built by King John in 1207, which is located less than a mile from the original brewery, and from where he rode out to Runnymede to seal the Magna Carta. The beer itself is deep amber in colour with a blend of pale and crystal malt. The bitterness and

fruity aroma are developed from a combination of hops.

#### Ruddy Darter - 4.6%

Named after a deep red dragon fly found in local rivers and wetlands. The beer uses malted rye to create its characteristic ruby glow. The flavours and aromas derive from a combination of English hops. A rich ruby ale with a fruity aroma.

# ANIMAL - Long Crendon, Buckinghamshire Bear - 4.6%

A current incarnation in XT Brewery's "Animal" series

#### Squawk - 4.6%

Another in XT Brewery's "Animal" series brewed with Columbus, Simcoe and Chinook along with Special B malt.

# ARKELL - Swindon, Wiltshire Wiltshire Gold - 3.7%

A light golden coloured ale brewed using English Maris Otter malt, which creates a satisfyingly sweet malty flavour. The use of traditional hops give the beer a mellow floral hop aroma followed by a distinctive hoppy taste.

#### Triple Bogey - 3.8%

A 'mega hoppy, triple hopped IPA'.

#### 3B - 4.0%

A superb amber brew with distinctive taste and a full nutty malt flavour beneath the hops.

#### Hoperation IPA - 4.2%

A blend of English and American hops brought together to create a powerful hop flavour in this pale ale with oats and wheat in the grist to provide a smooth rounded finish.

#### Moonlight - 4.5%

Moonlight has a golden auburn colour with a warm toasty aroma and distinctive citrus hoppy flavour from Celeia hops.

#### Strawberries 'N' Cream - 4.5%

Brewed with some barley, oats and wheat; topped up with hops from around the world, all selected for their summer fruity aromas, and finally a hint of strawberry to round this complex beer off as a refreshing summer pint - cheers!

# ARUNDEL - Arundel, Sussex Castle - 3.8%

A tawny coloured bitter with a hoppy aroma. The flavour has a good balance of malt, fruit and hops with a dry, hoppy finish.

#### Sussex Gold - 4.2%

A rich golden beer with a hoppy, citrus finish. Very smooth, light and refreshing.

#### Wild Heaven APA - 5.2%

An golden coloured american pale ale with a powerful citrus fruit aroma. The flavour is a stunning cocktail of grapefruit, orange, and lime, with a lingering dry bitter finish.

#### **ASCOT** - Camberley, Surrey

Alligator Ale - 4.6%
An American Pale Ale with a wonderful hoppy

An American Pale Ale with a wonderful hoppy nose from the Cascade hops. It's fresh, crisp, true to style with light carbonation and flowery hoppy notes. This is a unique and very quaffable ale indeed.

# AYLESBURY - Aylesbury, Buckinghamshire California Dreaming - 3.8%

California Dreaming is a West Coast Pale Ale showcasing the best of vibrant American hops. Golden as a Californian sunset, with big puncy aromas of pine, resin and citrus and a bitter kick upront, lead into a delightfully clean finish. A perfect summer session ale.

#### AYR - Ayr, Ayrshire

#### Leezie Lundie Pale Ale - 3.8%

Leezie Lundie is brewed using Savinjski Styrian Golding hops from Slovenia, to produce a fruity, pale golden, thirst quenching session Ale. The nose has Grapefruit and Pine which slowly opens up to give a delicate sweet maltiness. The palate is full and creamy with a long refreshing finish

#### **B & T** - Shefford, Bedfordshire

#### Shefford Bitter - 3.8%

A pale brown beer with a light hop aroma and a hoppy taste leading to a bitter finish brewed using Pearl Pale Malt, Crystal Malt, Challenger Hops, Golding Hops and Fuggle Hops

#### Fruit Bat - 4.5%

A straw coloured beer, malty and fruity, lightly hopped and tasting of raspberries.

#### Shefford Old Dark - 5.0%

A rich, fruity flavoured dark beer with caramel.

#### Shefford Old Strong - 5.0%

A rich mixture of fruit, hops and malt is present in the taste and aftertaste of this beer. Predominantly hoppy aroma.

#### BANK TOP - Bolton, Lancashire

**Dark Mild – 4.0%** 

Dark brown beer with a malt and roast aroma. Smooth mouthfeel, with malt, roast malt and hops prominent throughout.

#### **BEARTOWN** - Congleton, Cheshire

Ginger Bear – 4.0%

The flavours from the malt and hops blend with the added bite from root ginger to produce a superbly quenching finish.

#### Peach Melbear - 4.4%

Refreshing blonde ale, the hoppy bitterness is balanced by the sweet aroma of peaches and elderflower. A peach of a pint!

#### **BINGHAMS** - Ruscombe. Berkshire

Vanilla Stout - 5.0%

Infused with vanilla pods that complement the dark malts to create a smooth-drinking, deliciously dark stout.

#### BLACK SHEEP - Masham, North Yorkshire

Golden Sheep - 3.9%

A full flavoured cask ale with a dry and refreshing bitterness, developed with a light, citrus fruit flavour.

#### Pathmaker Pale Ale - 4.0%

Brewed with Chinook hops for an adventurous fresh aroma, juicy hop and a crisp moreish finish.

#### **BLACK TOR -** Christow, Devon

Pride of Dartmoor - 4.0%

This mid-brown session bitter has a gentle floral aroma and pleasant moor-ish taste.

#### Raven Bitter - 4.2%

A chestnut brown ale rich, smooth and malty brewed with a generous helping of English hops; full of flavour with caramel notes and summerfruit aromas. Named after the guardian of Black Tor.

#### **BLUE SQUARE - Morley, West Yorkshire**

Abyss Porter - 4.8%

Six different malts are blended in the creation of this dark porter. A recreation of a Victorian classic with depth of malt flavour and a balanced but not intrusive English hop finish.

#### **BOND** - Wokingham, Berkshire

Goldi-Hops - 3.9%

A refreshing amber-coloured pale ale with a malty and delicately citrusy nose, followed by a bitter flavour and a long, dry, bitter finish.

#### Best of British - 4.0%

A tawny best bitter with malt and fruit on the nose, dry fruity flavours balancing the bitterness, followed by a touch of blackcurrant in the aftertaste.

#### Railway Porter - 4.5%

An easy-drinking dark brown porter with a reddish tint. It has a subtle toasty maltiness with a gently-lingering fruity finish.

**BOSUN'S** - Horbury, West Yorkshire

Razamataz Raspberry Wheat - 3.7%

A raspberry flavoured blonde ale.

#### **BOUTILLIERS** - Faversham, Kent

Smoke Oatmeal Stout - 4.4%

A session-strength stout with a satisfying silky smooth finish from the oatmeal. German rauch malt adds a subtle yet well-balanced peat smokiness.

#### **BRADFIELD** - Sheffield, South Yorkshire

Farmers Yellow Jersey - 4.2%

A typical summer ale light on the palate with a summer fruit aroma.

#### **BRAINS** - Cardiff, Glamorgan

Dark - 3.5%

A skilful blend of dark and chocolate malts, gives this rich dark mild a full fine flavour. This beer has a delicate hop and chocolate aroma while the palate starts malty with a slight nuttiness, but then gives way to a light dry finish.

#### **BREW BUDDIES** - Swanley, Kent

Session Buddy - 3.7%

Session ale brewed with a light malt base and a medium mouth feel it is hopped liberally with East Kent Goldings, Aurora and Dana for a smooth hoppiness with fruity and floral character.

#### Best Bitter - 4.3%

Brewed with a mixture of malts to give hints of caramel and chocolate, and Challenger and Bobek hops to provide a rounded bitterness with spicy and fruity and floral notes.

#### Cascade Sybilla Pale Ale - 4.3%

This beer is packed with the fresh citrus flavour of American and European hops, added in copious amounts throughout the brew and as a dryhop for maximum flavour.

#### Wokka American Pale Ale - 4.8%

A simple grain bill of pale and Vienna malt allow the big resinous and tropical flavours of American Chinook and Mosaic hops to shine.

# BUFFYS - Tivetshall St Mary, Norfolk Hopleaf - 4.5%

An amber coloured beer with a sweet hoppy notes and a hint of vanilla. This easy drinking beer is smooth on the palate and has an excellent spicy edge.

#### Norwegian Blue - 4.9%

A mid-brown beer with a malt aroma and a hint of cherry. Malty and rich but never cloying, an old fashioned bitter.

#### **BURTON BRIDGE** - Burton upon Trent

#### Damson Porter - 4.5%

A dark fruity beer with added damson juice, which gives a distinctive bitterness.

# BUSHYS - Douglas, Isle of Man Old Bushy Tail - 4.5%

The first beer produced by Bushys brewery. An appealing reddish brown beer with a pronounced hop and malt aroma, the malt tending towards treacle. Slightly sweet and malty on the palate, with distinct orangey tones. The full finish is malty and hoppy a hint of toffee.

#### **CANTERBURY ALES** - Canterbury, Kent

Kent Triple Gold - 4.6%

Tasting notes unavailable at time of writing.

# CASTLE ROCK - Nottingham, Nottinghamshire Black Gold - 3.8%

A well balanced, dark mild ale with some bitterness, but not overly sweet.

#### Elsie Mo - 4.7%

A 'blonde' single malt beer. Light in colour and

refreshing on the palate, with a pleasant crisp aftertaste and a wonderful aroma.

#### **CAVEMAN** - Swanscombe, Kent

#### Palaeolithic - 3.8%

A light session beer with a dose of aromatic hops. Well balanced and highly drinkable this beer is the Swanscombe Man's favourite brew, which is why it was named after the Palaeolithic Era. Sweet malts balance out the Grapefruit and Citrus from the US Amarillo and Cascade hops to give an easy drinking session pale ale.

#### Megalithic - 5.9%

Theres not a lot of subtlety about this beer. Big on malt, big on hops. A big biscuity malt body is balanced against a heavy hit of fruit from a blend of US hops and a fairly dry finish

#### **CHURCH HANBREWERY - Church**

Hanborough, Oxfordshire

#### Ale X - 4.5%

A powerful and complex IPA with citrus, pine, spice and herbal notes.

#### Red Beeter - 5.0%

Brown-red in colour from a small amount of organic beetroot juice. Very malty, smooth, with low hop aroma, and a balanced hop bitterness.

#### Witty Bea - 5.0%

This one is for the witbier appreciator. We improved the traditional Belgian beer style by adding notes of mandarin and garden herbs and created a beer for the exploratory mind. The result is Witty Bea, an extremely refreshing and easy drinking beer that is aromatic and flavourful, a perfect match for spicy food. Try with a slice of orange or lemon or a dash of lemonade.

#### Rauk - 5.0%

An English beer with a German accent, this ale is inspired by the Rauchbier (smoked lager) from Bamberg.

#### Bluenette - 5.5%

A dark brown porter with a smoothness that comes from the addition of Scottish rolled oats, a delicate sweetness from organic honey and rich roasted chocolate flavours.

#### Mat Black - 5.5%

A black IPA with a strong lemony and herbal hop aroma and the smoothness of a stout.

#### 1 4 Keeps - 5.5%

One For Keeps is a characterful ale of French origin. The dark amber colour, the moderate body, the pleasant malty sweetness, and the light hop bitterness, lift the unmistakeable yeast character.

#### Ze Braun - 5.5%

Presenting beautiful dark toffee translucency, deliciously complex malt structure and low balancing bitterness, Ze Braun is our creamy, unfiltered and unclarified dunkelweizen (dark wheat bear). The blended yeast strain adds delicate natural clove, vanilla and banana notes.

# **CLARKS -** Wakefield, West Yorkshire **Classic Blonde -** 3.9%

Traditional pale ale with a smooth hoppy taste strongly enhanced with citrus fruits.

# **CLARKSHAWS** - Loughborough Junction, Greater London

#### Gorgon's Alive - 4.0%

Unfined golden coloured beer with spicy hops throughout. The flavour has hints of orange and peach with a dry bitterness.

#### Phoenix Rising - 4.0%

Tawny beer with a creamy toffee nose. Bananas, pineapple, hops and caramel flavours. Dryish, short fruity biscuit finish.

#### Strange Brew No.1 - 4.0%

Easy-drinking yellow coloured 'pale ale'. Flavour is of peppery hops, tropical fruits and biscuit sweetness with a trace of bitterness.

#### Hellhound IPA - 5.5%

Spiced and citrus notes in this unfined amber beer with a bitterness in the flavour and finish, which is dry.

#### **COACH HOUSE** - Howley, Cheshire

Coachmans Summer Ale - 4.0%

Distinctive light golden coloured beer fully fermented to give a dry clean taste.

#### Dick Turpin - 4.2%

A medium coloured, golden brew with exceptional appearance in the glass. It has a mellow, hoppy

nose, full toffee like malty palate and smooth aftertaste.

#### Apricot - 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of apricot.

#### Banoffee - 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of banoffee.

#### Blueberry - 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of blueberry.

#### Cherry - 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of cherries.

#### **Coconut - 5.0%**

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of coconut.

#### Cranberry - 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of cranberry

#### Lemon and Ginger- 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of lemon and ginger

#### Passion Fruit – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of passion fruit.

#### Pineapple – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of pineapple.

#### Pink Grapefruit – 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of pink grapefruit.

#### Raspberry - 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of raspberry.

#### Strawberry - 5.0%

Pale in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of strawberry.

#### **COASTAL** - Redruth, Cornwall

#### Merry Maidens Mild – 4.0%

A classic dark mild with a good chocolate malt flavour.

#### Poseidon Extra - 4.5%

A pale gold ale packed with citrus hop and fruity flavours, rounded off by a fresh citrus blast. pronounced citra hop aromas throughout.

#### Cornish Cascade - 5.0%

Single hopped golden ale with Cascade for a citrus, fruity character.

# COTLEIGH - Wiveliscombe, Somerset Calypso - 4.3%

A classic, well balanced traditional bitter brewed using local malted barley and English whole hops.

#### **DALESIDE -** Harrogate, North Yorkshire

Brewery Best Bitter - 4.1%

#### **DARK STAR** - Partridge Green, Sussex

—— Hophead - 3.8%

An extremely clean-drinking pale golden ale with a strong floral aroma and elderflower notes from the Cascade hops. This beer is full-bodied and full-flavoured yet gentle enough to make it a favourite session beer.

#### Partridge Best - 4.0%

A Best Bitter brewed in a traditional Sussex style using Maris Otter, Crystal and Chocolate malts with East Kent Golding hops. Typical of Dark Star ales, the Best Bitter relies on the heavy handed addition of aromatic hops late in the boil.

#### Espresso - 4.2%

A black beer brewed with roasted barley malt and challenger hops. Then freshly ground Arabica coffee beans, blended especially for Dark Star, are added to the copper for a few minutes after the boil to provide a rich and complementary coffee aroma.

#### Sunburst - 4.6%

A hint of initial sweetness adds to the fruitiness of this summer ale without detracting from its clean flavour and rich hop aroma.

#### American Pale Ale - 4.7%

A yeast strain used for the brewing of the pale dry American ales was specially imported from the USA, along with some Chinook and Centennial hops, to produce this pale ale. The pale Maris Otter malt provides a perfect light colour and dryness to complement the crisp taste and full aroma of the hops.

#### **DONNINGTON** - Stow-on-the-Wold.

BB - 3.6%

A pleasant amber bitter with a slight hop aroma, a good balance of malt and hops in the mouth and a bitter aftertaste.

#### Gold - 4.0%

This award-winning beer has a golden colour with a citrus flavor followed by a rounded malt finish.

#### **SBA - 4.4%**

Malt dominates over bitterness in the subtle flavour of this premium bitter, which has a hint of fruit and a dry, malty finish.

#### **DORKING -** Dorking, Surrey

Pacific Gold - 3.8%
This sun-drenched golden ale is h

This sun-drenched golden ale is bursting with New Zealand hops, and at 3.8% you know it'll be refreshing.

#### Pilcrow Pale - 4.1%

The palest and hoppiest beer to date from this brewery. Big on the tropical and citrus aromas.

#### **DB One - 4.2%**

Hoppy best bitter with underlying orange fruit notes. Some balancing malt sweetness in the taste leads to a dry bitter finish.

#### Lunar White - 4.6%

Hopped up wheat beer. Using Simcoe, Mosaic, and Belgian Candi Sugar.

#### Buffalo Buffalo - 5.1%

An American Pale Ale with aroma of lemon and peaches with toffee, grapefruit and passion fruit on the palate. A long pleasant bitter finish

#### **DOWNTON** - Downton, Wiltshire

Bogus Buffalo - 4.6%

A classic American Pale ale; golden in colour with 5% crystal malt, perfectly flavoured with all American hop varieties. Refreshingly different, with a zesty, pine character throughout.

#### Chocolate Orange Delight - 5.8%

Originally offered as a Christmas special, this old ale has proven to be a favourite all year round. Distinctive chocolate and orange flavour notes work excellently against a rich, hoppy background.

ELGOODS - Wisbech, Cambridgeshire

Beer Goggles - 5.0%

Strong blonde beer.

ELLAND - Elland, West Yorkshire
Nettlethrasher - 4.4%

A deep copper coloured traditional ale, brewed using six different malts and developing interesting flavours from the combined use of English and American hop varieties. All this goes together to make this a mighty mouthful.

1872 Porter - 6.5%

Rich, complex and dark porter from an original 1872 recipe, with an old port nose, and coffee and bitter chocolate flavours on the palate.

**ERRANT** - Newcastle upon Tyne, Tyne & Wear Comanche Porter - 4.5%

A classic black porter brewed with Bramling Cross and New Zealand Dr. Rudi hops. Comanche is a proud porter with plenty of tasty hops and malt character, a perfect dark ale.

FIRST CHOP - Salford, Greater Manchester

JAM Mango Pale Ale - 4.0%

The malt base creates a sweetness to compliment the mango infusion. A lot of late hopping with Chinook and Cascade gives a juxtaposing bitterness that balances this beer to perfection. Dry hopped with Citra. Gluten Free.

POD Vanilla Stout - 4.2%

A classic oatmeal stout, the vanilla really bringing out the chocolate flavours, beautifully balanced bitterness and peppery, spicy hopping with hints of citrus. Gluten Free.

FIVE POINTS - Hackney, Greater London
Pale - 4.4%

A fresh, zesty, aromatic pale ale brewed with malted barley, a little wheat, and Amarillo and Citra hops from the West Coast of the USA. The British ale tradition collides head first with the best of the US craft beer movement, resulting in an incredibly drinkable Pale Ale with tonnes of US hop aroma and flavour

Brick Field Brown - 5.4%

Our take on the traditional English brown ale.

This is a well balanced, full bodied beer brewed with all-British barley and Golden Naked Oats, coupled with Willamette hops from the USA. Earthy aromas and flavours of demerara and hazelnuts. It's a hug in a glass.

Hook Island Red - 6.0%

A full bodied, aromatic Red Rye ale brewed with malted barley, the addition of 20% Rye to the recipe, and with Chinook, Columbus and Simcoe hops. We think the Rye in the recipe gives some dryness and spice, and the hops add a dash of pine and passion fruit, but see what you think, everyone's taste buds are different. This is an incredibly flavoursome Red Ale, full of lots of interesting tastes and aromas.

FLYING MONK - Malmesbury, Wiltshire

Jackdaw Porter - 4.3%

Early in the 1100 Century, Elmer, after observing the Jackdaws soaring on the breeze around the Abbey towers thought man could possibly fly. Elmer constructed wings and launched himself from the top of Malmesbury Abbey, managing a flight of about 200 yards.

FRANKLINS - Bexhill on Sea, Sussex

English Garden - 3.8%

This Pale Ale is recommended for lovers of hops who want to drink more and more. Its rich hop aroma is balanced by biscuity malt with a slight sweetness and is wrapped up in a wave bright golden colour.

FULLERS - Chiswick, Greater London

London Pride - 4.1%

A smooth and astonishingly complex beer, which has a distinctive malty base complemented by a rich balance of well developed hop flavours from the Target, Challenger and Northdown varieties in the brew.

**ESB - 5.5%** 

First brewed in 1971, ESB is unrivalled in terms of its flavour and balance. A powerful 5.5%, it is brewed from Pale Ale and Crystal malts, and from Target, Challenger, Northdown and Goldings hops.

GALES - Chiswick, Greater London

This pale golden coloured beer has a smooth mouthfeel . The sweet biscuity malt is balanced by some pineapple and citrus pithy fruit/ The finish is dry with a building bitterness. The hops are First Gold and Citra and it uses only pale malt.

#### Harvard American Pale Ale - 5.5%

Sweet honey flavour with sweet orange and grapefruit marmalade character are present in this pale brown beer. Dry bitter finish and a rich, smooth mouthfeel. A complex blend of hops including Chinook, Citra, Cascade Northern Brewer and Summit. The malts are simpler with Maris Otter, pale and crystal. The beer is named after John Harvard (of the American university fame) who came from the area.

# STONEHENGE - Netheravon, Wiltshire Great Bustard - 4.8%

Brewed to celebrate the reintroduction of the Great Bustard onto Salisbury Plains. The colour is deep amber with a red hue, the taste is deliciously fruity and malty with a lingering bitter aftertaste.

STRATHAVEN - Strathaven. Strathclyde
Ebony Oatmeal Stout - 4.4%
An oatmeal stout!

# TITANIC - Burslem, Staffordshire Blue Moon - 4.2% Cherry Dark - 4.4%

This black bitter uses US and Slovenian hops and is infused with cherries that subtly come through on the aftertaste. A beer to be cherished!

#### Cappuccino Stout - 4.5%

Combining the brewer's and the barista's talents this fabulous beer combines the original dry Titanic Stout with the flavours of warm, enveloping smooth cappuccino. Relax and enjoy, with or without chocolate sprinkles.

#### Raspberry Wheat (Hazy) - 4.7%

A delightful fruit wheat beer which is hazy in appearance due to the high percentage of wheat malt in the recipe and has light raspberry aromas and taste.

#### Captain Smith - 5.2%

A red/brown, full bodied beer hoppy and bitter with a sweetness and roast malt flavour and a good strong finish.

# TRING - Tring, Hertfordshire Brock Bitter - 3.7%

A light brown quaffing ale with a hint of sweetness and caramel on the palate. Challenger hops imparted a gentle bitterness, which is matched by a late hop aroma from Styrian Goldings.

#### Pale + Four - 4.6%

Hops, hops and more hops, although this is not just another one dimensional 'lupin fest'. Cara, Munich and Rye Crystal malts provide a robust base for this punchy American West Coast IPA style beer.

#### TRYST - Larbert, Fife

Raj IPA - 5.5%

A full-strength traditional India Pale ale. Hopped with three popular British hops to produce a deep lingering taste, complementing the underlying malts for a memorable pint.

#### TWICKENHAM - Twickenham, Middlesex

Sundancer - 3.7%

A crisp and hoppy session bitter. Amber malt provides a pleasant biscuity edge to this pale golden coloured ale. A blend of British and

American hops add a wonderfully floral and citrus-like, long dry finish.

#### Grandstand - 3.8%

A well-hopped and well balanced, brownish amber refreshing session beer. Refreshing, with light citrus hoppy notes and a fresh clean finish.

#### Redhead - 4.1%

Roasted barley, along with a blend of pale/dark crystal malts and caramalt give this red hued beer a soft maltiness with roasted notes, whilst the English/German hop mix gives it a spicy hop character

#### Naked Ladies - 4.4%

Hoppy beer using Pioneer and Styrian Goldings for full-flavoured satisfaction. Good body and luscious aroma.

#### Summer Sun - 4.4%

Very pale, very hoppy beer with an excellent flavour. Extra pale ale and wheat malts combine with the aromatic Citra hop to make a very bright and refreshing pint for a warm summer's day.

#### Gothick Dark - 4.6%

A strong, dark mild brewed using pale crystal and two types of chocolate malt. Full-bodied and malty but with a dryish, chocolatey edge. Inspired by Strawberry Hill House, the "Little Gothick Castle", not so far from the brewery.

#### London Gold - 4.9%

Big hoppy flavour and nose with juicy malt underpinnings; long pleasing dry hoppy finish. With four American and two British hops, it's a cosmopolitan brew worthy of such a great city.

#### Daisy Cutter - 6.1%

Strong, well-hopped ale. Powerful golden coloured beer. A skillful blend of American hops makes this a beer to be reckoned with. Fruity, citrus nose and flavour.

#### **UPHAM** - Upham, Hampshire

#### \_\_\_\_\_ Tipster - 3.6%

A delicious, easy drinking dry hopped ale. Light Golden, coloured with refreshing citrus notes complement the smooth bitterness derived from a complex blend of English and American hops.

A strong, pale ale packed with hop and Citrus flavours, rounded off by a dry malty biscuit finish. A pronounced hop aroma throughout.

# VIP - Alnwick, Northumberland The Village Gossip - 3.3%

A lower abv, but what it lacks in volume certainly makes up for in taste and flavour. Well hopped blonde beer with Willamette, Simcoe and Cascade to make a beautiful floral, citrus and spicy finish.

#### Alnwick Amber Ale - 3.8%

Classic amber ale with a strong infusion of fuggles and styrian goldings hops specifically for the North Eastern palate to balance the best quality Maris Otter and crystal malts base. Good hoppy nose and biscuity body. An all day "session" ale if ever there was one.

#### The Village Bike - 4.0%

A smooth British ale using all English ingredients. A slightly sweet tongue feel with a mild bitter aftertaste.

#### The Village Lite - 4.0%

A very light American Pale ale. Bursting with a citrus kick with a mouth watering grapefruit aftertaste

#### Alnwick Gold - 4.2%

A brilliant golden (blonde) ale with an especially pronounced hop character from its First Gold hops which offers clean refreshing flavours and aromas. With its well-structured malt body derived

WANTSUM - Hersden, Kent

**Black Pig - 4.8%** 

Nickname for the Spanish Armada, whose wreckage was washed up on the coast near Deal after they were sunk by the English fleet and weather. Adapted from an imperial Russian porter recipe, this beer is incredibly smooth with burnt chocolate and smoky malt notes mixed with delicate hop bitterness and floral notes. Made from 100% British Fuggles hops.

WEIRD BEARD - Hanwell, Middlesex

Little Things That Kill - 3.9%

Hoppy, fruity golden ale which varies in flavour as the hops that are used can alter.

Decadence Stout - 5.5%

Orange with some black treacle sweetness balances the dry chocolate and coffee character that lingers pleasantly with the bitterness developing.

Hit the Lights - 5.8%

English malt back bone, bittered with Angelo/Euro hops in the shape of Target and Aurora, then dry hopped with the same again. American yeast to keep esters at bay, so all that fruity punch comes just from the hops. Making a clean, bitter IPA with loads of fruity hop character, the way we think it should be. Like any good IPA this beer will cut

through spicy dishes, pair well with fried or salty foods, but best enjoyed in the sun.

#### Peat Rock - 6.5%

For this beer Weird Beard went back to the old school, taking inspiation from the original brown porter style. But they couldn't just stop there - they had to bring a little Weird Beard flavour to the jam. They took the best elements of a brown porter, dialled up the ABV, added generous amounts of El Dorado and Summit hops, and dropped some big heavy peat notes in the mix. The result is a beer like no other. Complex, bursting with hop character and full of peat, this beer is as innovative and unique as its namesake.

#### Sorachi Faceplant - 8.1%

This beer is a mash-up of Little Things that Kill Batch 8 (a.k.a Sorachi Face Punch) with our Holy Hoppin' Hell recipe. What you get is an imperial I.P.A bursting with Sorachi Ace flavour that does not disappoint.

#### Follow the Worms - 8.5%

A 'Mexican Export Stout', mixing agave with the perfect amount of chilli. Its name and label reference both current political affairs and song lyrics...Jonny was never one to guell his opinions.

#### **Welbeck Abbey**

Welbeck, Nottinghamshire

#### Henrietta - 3.6%

A clean-tasting, delicate golden ale, brewed with German Hallertau Brewers Gold which contribute notes of honeysuckle and fresh hav.

#### Red Feather - 3.9%

This is a robust auburn ale. Plenty of crystal malt gives this beer a rich colour and combination of bold walnut and bitter-sweet caramel flavours.

#### Harley - 4.3%

Harley uses a blend of American and German hops to give an opulently floral honey-colour ale. Orange blossom and fresh zest are at the forefront with subtle sweetness behind.

#### Portland Black - 4.5%

A rich, velvety dark porter. Subtle smoke, chocolate and iced coffee flavours from roasted malts are topped off with a distinctly vanilla aroma.

# WELLS - Bedford, Bedfordshire Eagle IPA - 3.6%

A refreshing amber session bitter with pronounced citrus hop aroma and palate, faint malt in the mouth, and a lasting dry bitter finish.

#### Young's Bitter - 3.7%

Pale golden dry bitter which has a fresh clean nose and an aroma of hops and citrus fruit.

#### Young's London Gold – 4.0%

A dark gold beer with a smooth mouthfeel. Citrus and malt in the low aroma, coming through more strongly on the palate and aftertaste with a little peach. Dry finish.

#### Bombardier - 4.1%

A burnished copper colour with a rich, tempting aroma of peppery hops and raisins. The palate is dominated by more dark fruit, juicy malt and tangy hops.

#### Young's Special - 4.5%

Pale brown bitter with a full, slightly estery nose and a good hop aroma and full round flavour, a fine balance between malt & hops.

#### WILD WEATHER - Silchester, Hampshire

#### Serendipity - 3.9%

An explosively fruity American Pale Ale. Big American hops deliver a huge nose over a subtle malt bill

#### Betrayal - 4.0%

Mosaic APA. Betrayal takes tropical fruit hop notes and smashes through them like a mango being hit with a baseball bat!!. First comes waves of limes and pineapple, followed by mangos and oranges. Leaving the mouth coated with full hop sensation.

#### Back To The Winchester - 4.5%

Red ale brewed with 100% Red X malt and dry hopped with Australian Galaxy

#### Be Hop A Lula - 4.9%

Hopped up IPA. Delivers a foxy multi fruit face melter with scorching aromatics

#### WINDSOR & ETON - Windsor, Berkshire

**Parklife - 3.2%** 

A light, refreshing ale with a surprisingly full body and hop character for its relatively low alcohol.

#### Knight of the Garter - 3.8%

Straw-coloured golden ale. Easy summer drinking with a distinctive fresh citrus hop aroma.

#### Corker Summer Bitter - 4.0%

Corker! is made using Melanoidin malt to give a pale ale colour but it's then hopped using English Fuggles & Australian Enigma hops. The real fun however starts with the addition of the "dry hop" of Elderflower (from the plant at the brewery) and Lemon Myrtle. The resultant beer has a lovely floral, soft fruit and citrus aroma to entice you in. Against a lovely biscuity, light malt base the main features of then shine through with a lemon zestiness that gives the beer a wonderful refreshing character.

#### Firefly Blonde - 4.0%

A seriously blonde beer brewed with the lightest of malts. The palate is light bread & biscuit with a wonderful hop flavour & aroma from Eureka hops giving blackcurrant & herbal notes - very refreshing.

#### Windsor Knot – 4.0%

Windsor Knot is made with the finest natural ingredients including two specially selected hops, Sovereign and Nelson Sauvin.

#### Guardsman - 4.2%

Copper-coloured session strength ale with a tangy taste, smoothed by oak conditioning and a really fresh hop. It is brewed with premium Maris Otter pale malt and a blend of Pilgrim, Styrian Golding and Fuggles hops.

#### Eton Boatman - 4.3%

Made with a combination of American Citra hops, producing citrus flavours, and Australian Galaxy hops giving hints of exotic fruit with a fresh, clean and full flavoured taste.

#### Continuous IPA - 4.5%

Kohinoor is a Jubilee beer inspired by Commonwealth ingredients. The "Kohinoor" is the large diamond in the Coronation Crown and we think this beer is a diamond of equal brilliance! A classic Indies Pale Ale, using Imperial Malt, Chinook, Simcoe and Pacific Jade hops, it has a light, dry bitter taste with jaggery sugar, jasmine petals, cardamon and coriander balancing the lemony hop character.

#### WOLD TOP - Wold Newton, East Yorkshire

#### Angler's Reward - 4.0%

The ultimate catch, a refreshing golden pale ale with a fruity bitterness & lingering aftertaste. Brewed with Wold grown malts and hopped with the fruity Cascade and Goldings hops.

#### WOLF - Attleborough, Norfolk

Norfolk Lavender Honey - 3.7%

Honey infused with lavender is added during the brewing process to give this beer a delicate yet moreish flavour.

# WORSTHORNE - Burnley, Lancashire Blackthorne Stout - 4.9%

A smooth rich Stout, with liquorish and caramel flavours, a hint of berries and a satisfying lingering bitterness, derived from the use of carefully selected dark roasted malts and English hops.
